SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **PLEASE** provide copies of registration papers with your entries. **Copies** of papers **must be** provided to the show officials by processing time.
4. **Substitutions** will be allowed, (as in General Rule # 14), provided the animal is owned by the exhibitor at closing date of manual entry.
5. **The use of any PAINT product is not allowed at Canadian Angus Gold Shows. This rule will be strictly enforced and any animal in violation will be excused from the show. There will not be any AEROSOLS allowed in the marshalling area.**
6. **Scanning:** Will be the option of the exhibitor at exhibitor’s expense.
7. Cattle will be stabled according to the discretion of the Angus barn boss. Single entries must be shown, otherwise they will be moved to an outside area for the duration of the show.
8. It will be compulsory for Angus exhibitors to wear a dark, sleeveless v-necked sweater or vest, over a light coloured shirt in the show ring. Vests are available from the Saskatchewan Angus Association.
9. Exhibitors will have the option to sell show animals at the discretion of the Sales Management.
10. Any Angus shown at Canadian Western Agribition is subject to parentage tests and/or DNA typing. (Test to be supervised by the Canadian Angus Association.)
11. **All Canadian owned animals MUST have a Canadian registration paper in order to show.**
12. Cattle showing with foreign registration papers must be 100% Angus.
13. **Splitting of Classes:** After arrival at the show, classes will be split as warranted by number of animals.

NOTE: Black Angus animals show in Section 100A; Red Angus show in Section 101. In the event of mixed (black & red) cow/calf units, entry **must be made based on the colour of the dam. When making entry, **be sure to make it very clear which section you are entering.****

SECTION 100A (Black) or 101 (Red)

CLASS

1. Female, born 2011. Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into a maximum of three divisions - Junior, Intermediate & Senior. Splits will be made in each division as required.
2. Junior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
3. Intermediate Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
4. Senior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
5. Female, born 2010. Class may be divided into 3 divisions pending entries. Junior (fall heifers), Intermediate, and Senior.
6. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
7. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
8. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
9. Female, born in 2009 with her own **natural**, purebred, 2011, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for classes 1 or 13, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd.
10. Female, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own **natural**, purebred, 2011, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for classes 1 or 13, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd.
11. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female.
12. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
13. Bull, born 2011. Upon completion of processing, **if entries warrant**, class will be divided into a maximum of three divisions - Junior, Intermediate & Senior. Splits will be made in each division as required.
14. Junior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
15. Intermediate Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
16. Senior Division, Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
17. Bull, born January 1 - June 30, 2010.
18. Bull, born July 1 - December 31, 2010.
19. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
20. Bull, born 2009.
21. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
22. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
23. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limit one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
24. Premier Breeder.
25. Premier Exhibitor.

PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Will be calculated as follows: 1st place - 6 points; 2nd place - 5 points; 3rd place - 4 points; 4th place - 3 points; 5th place - 2 points; 6th place - 1 point. Points will be awarded to the top 6 placing animals of each breeder's or exhibitor's string. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd class.

Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain extra points.

Premier Breeder: Points will be allocated to the Breeding unit which bred the animal. A breeding unit is defined as the immediate family breeding cattle under that farm name. The members of a breeding unit will be decided by the show and sale committee. Jointly bred cattle are considered as a separate entity. No split points will be awarded.

Premier Exhibitor: The exhibitor must own the animal at the time of entry. In the case of jointly owned animals, points will be awarded to one owner only as specified on the entry form. The responsibility of designating exhibitor, lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry, and included on that exhibitor's entry form.

HERDSMAN AWARDS

Awards will be presented by the Saskatchewan Angus Association to the herdsman or exhibitor putting on the best display during Agribition. Judging will take place throughout the show.

“THE MASTERPIECE SALE”

Presented by the SASKATCHEWAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION

1. Open to all ages; both male and female; red and black.
2. All sale animals must be entered for show at Agribition, and applicable show entry fees paid.
3. Entries will be selected and catalogued by Sale Management.
4. Sale animals will be allowed to leave after 6:00 p.m. the day of the sale. Animals that are remaining to show on Thursday **must remain at Agribition until release time on Saturday.**
