SHOW: Bulls will show immediately following the Bred, Open Replacement Heifers and "Show Only" Heifer Alley during the Commercial Cattle Show, Friday, November 25 - Stockman's Arena.

****BULLS MAY BEGIN ARRIVAL AT 8:00 a.m., SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 19 ALL BULLS MUST BE IN PENS BY 2:00 p.m. THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 24.**

SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entries accompanied by fees must be received by **October 15**.
3. **Entry Fee:** Pen of Three Bulls - \$100.00/pen. Non-refundable. **GST payable on all fees.**
4. **Eligible Animals:** All bulls must have been born the property of the exhibitor or breeding unit exhibiting and **must be registered and tattooed:**
 - (a) Pens of Three Bulls born January 1 - April 30, 2011.
 - (b) Pens of Three Bulls born in 2010.
5. **Limit of Entries:** Two pens per exhibitor per class.
6. Special Pens of Bulls summary information forms **must be completed with all pertinent information on each individual bull in the pen and must be returned with entries to the CWA office by October 15.** (Recordation/Registration Certificates, or copies thereof, **must** accompany all bulls upon arrival).
7. **Weighing:** All bulls will be weighed as unloaded, **Wednesday, November 23, 8:00 - 10:00 a.m. and after 4:00 p.m. with commercial cattle. No weighing on Tuesday, November 22.**
8. **Classes:** After arrival at Agribition, bulls will be designated to classes according to average age in days.
9. Animals will be shown in their natural condition. Cattle may be washed and brushed, however; **NO clipping is allowed!** Animals found to have ever been clipped will not be allowed to show and will be removed from the barn.
10. The committee strongly recommends that all bull calves be preconditioned. Preconditioning forms and livestock ownership must accompany cattle to the show. Do not mail into the CWA office.
11. The use of wood chips for bedding under the Bull Pen Alley bulls in the commercial barn is **not allowed.**
12. Exhibitors are required to provide necessary equipment for feeding and watering.
13. Depending on the number of entries in the Commercial Cattle Show, all efforts will be made to accommodate all animals in the barn. However, if necessary, some may be housed outside.
14. Agribition stall cards will be provided for all bulls. These cards must be displayed in their entirety.
15. **All bulls entered in the Bull Pen Alley Show must remain displayed as a group in their allotted pens in the Commercial Cattle barn. Exceptions will only be made for those bulls participating in the Breeders Display of the Beef Trade Show. Then one animal per pen may be removed for use in the display.**

16. **Animals may only be shown once. Halters may be left on the junior bulls, but they will be shown loose, however, all long yearling bulls must be haltered at all times and shown with either a ring or a nose lead. For safety reasons, long yearling bulls are to be led at all times. Pens will enter and be shown as a group.**
17. Each pen will be allotted a show number. Exhibitors must wear this number in the front and back of a show harness while showing.
18. **In order to qualify for a breed show, a breed must have a minimum of three pens shown, consisting of any combination (calves or yearlings). Breeds not qualifying for a breed show will be put into an Inter-breed class.**
19. Bulls entered in the Bull Pen Alley Show can be released **after** the Commercial Cattle Sale, Saturday, November 26.
20. The Supreme Champion and all Grand Champion pens will be paraded immediately before the sale of the bred heifers. Exhibitors must be present to parade their bulls. Any exhibitor not in attendance is subject to CWA disciplinary action. Exhibitors have the option to sell one animal from each pen during the Commercial Cattle Sale. All other bulls entered in the Bull Pen Alley Show are eligible to sell by private treaty.

NOTE: Electronic marketing devices (video machines, etc.) are not permitted in the stalling area of the commercial cattle barn.

PRIZE MONEY

\$200.00 is offered to the Grand Champion Pens providing three or more pens are exhibited per breed. Any additional prize money will be determined by the respective Breed Associations.
