**SHOW RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. Females born prior to May 1 of the previous year, that are being shown in the yearling heifer classes are required to have certification of pregnancy prepared by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days prior to the show date. Certificate must be presented at time of processing or animal will be disqualified.
4. All bulls 18 months of age and over must carry a satisfactory semen test certificate within 60 days prior to the show date. Certificate must be presented at time of processing or animal will be disqualified. Bulls with proof of having been drawn successfully or having registered progeny, **do not** require semen tests.
5. **All bulls over 12 months of age are required to have a nose lead or ring when out of their stalls. Violation will be subject to a fine of \$50.00.**
6. **Weights and Measurements:** During the arrival period, **all animals must be weighed** and have height measurements taken. For bulls, scrotal measurements will also be taken at that time by qualified personnel. Immediately prior to entering the show ring, bulls may be weighed again. All weights and measurements will be made available to the audience for each class.
7. Exhibitors must wear the black Charolais Association show sweater or vest in the show ring. White shirt preferred.
8. **Splitting of Classes:** After processing, classes will be subdivided as warranted by number of animals.
9. **Stabling:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to contact the barn boss and report the **accurate** number of cattle being brought to the show. Contact - Dennis Metz, Phone: (306)731-2800.

**SECTION 115**

**CLASS**

1. Female, purebred, born in 2011. (Minimum of three months of age.) Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Junior Division will comprise the younger half of the 2011 heifers and the Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 heifers. Should entries in each division exceed 15 exhibits, the classes will be split as required.
2. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Futurity Female.
3. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Futurity Female.
4. Female, purebred, born in 2010.
5. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female.
6. Female, purebred, born in 2009 with her own 2011 **natural**, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 10, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire and Produce-of-Dam classes.
7. Female, purebred, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own 2011, **natural**, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 10, but is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire and Produce-of-Dam classes.
8. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female.
9. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
10. Bull, purebred, born in 2011. (Minimum of three months of age.) Upon completion of processing, class will be divided into Junior and Senior Divisions. The Senior Division will be comprised of the older half of the 2011 bulls. The Junior Division will be comprised of the younger half of the 2011 bulls. Should entries in each Division exceed 15 exhibits, the classes will be split as required.
11. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Futurity Bull.

12. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Futurity Bull.
13. Bull, purebred, born in 2010.
14. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
15. Bull, purebred, born in 2009.
16. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
17. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
18. Produce-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age from the same dam. At least one animal owned by exhibitor. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
19. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
20. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
21. Premier Breeder.
22. Premier Exhibitor.

### PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

*Premier Breeder and Exhibitor awards will be calculated as follows:*

*1st place - 6 points; 2nd place - 5 points; 3rd place - 4 points; 4th place - 3 points; 5th place - 2 points; 6th place - 1 point.*

- *Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain additional points.*
- *In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd.*
- ***Premier Exhibitor** points will be awarded on the basis of prizes won by six animals owned by that exhibitor at the time of closing of entries, with the highest placings in classes for single animals. Animals in joint ownership can be shown in joint names, however, only one owner can gain points for Premier Exhibitor. The responsibility of designating exhibitor lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry, and included on that exhibitor's summary form.*
- ***Premier Breeder:** Points will be awarded to the breeder on the basis of prizes won by animals bred by that exhibitor with the highest placings in the classes for single animals. Jointly bred animals are considered as a separate entity. No split points will be awarded.*

### HERDSMAN AWARD

*A trophy will be awarded to the herdsman or exhibitor putting on the best display during the period of Agribition. The winner will be declared by a judge selected by the Saskatchewan Charolais Association Show Committee. Neatness of the exhibit, grooming of cattle and courtesy displayed by the attendants will be determining factors.*

### CHAROLAIS SALE

1. The sale offering will be preselected as well as selected directly from the Canadian Western Agribition Charolais Show.
2. Sales Commission will include 3% to CWA.
3. The sale will be managed by By Livestock, and sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Charolais Association.
