**\*\*Commercial cattle may begin arrival at 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 23 and must be in their pens by 2:00 p.m., Thursday, November 24.**

**\*\*WEIGHING:** All cattle must be weighed as they are unloaded. Feeder/backgrounder cattle and open heifers will sell off truck weight with a graduated scale for shrinkage. (Mileage to be recorded on the manifest, manifest to accompany cattle to the scale, or 3% shrink may automatically be taken.) **Commercial Cattle arriving prior to printed arrival times will be sold at a 3% shrink.**

**Cattle will be released immediately following the sale.**

### SHOW AND SALE RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entries, accompanied by fees must be received by November 1.**
3. **Eligible Animals:** Bred Replacement Heifers born in 2010.  
Open Replacement Heifers born in 2011.  
Backgrounder/Feeder Steers & Heifers born in 2011.  
(Straight and crossbred eligible in all sections).  
Breed of sire and dam **must** be listed on the entry form for each pen entry in order to qualify for Breed Specials and also for the benefit of buyers.
4. **Entry Fees: GST payable on all fees.**
  - a) Backgrounder Steers, Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, & Open Replacement Heifers: \$7.50/head(non-refundable). **GST payable on all fees.**
  - b) Bred Replacement Heifers - \$35.00/head (\$20.00 refundable upon showing and will be credited with sales commission). **GST payable on all fees.**
5. **All Cattle must bear a CCIA Tag upon arrival and MUST be individually identified with the nine-digit CCIA number recorded on the Pre-conditioning and Pregnancy forms in order to Show and Sell.**
6. **NEW: All COMMERCIAL CATTLE ENTERED MUST be Age Verified** and accompanied by a birth certificate.
7. All feeder cattle and open replacement heifers must be preconditioned.

**Note: Pre-conditioning forms and livestock ownership must accompany cattle to the show. Please fill out individual forms for each pen/entry. Do not mail into the CWA office. Forms are available on CWA website [www.agribition.com](http://www.agribition.com).**

**CWA Certified Preconditioning Program. Protect Our Reputation. Vaccinate cattle following CWA Rules and Guidelines.**

Eligibility requirements include:

- a) Cattle must be owned for sixty days by the exhibitor who is preconditioning them.
  - b) Calves must be weaned and on feed by entry deadline.
  - c) Castration & dehorning must be completed 30 days prior to the sale.
  - d) Calves must be over 4 months of age at time of vaccination.
  - e) All vaccinations must be administered at least 3 weeks prior to sale.
  - f) Vaccinations required:
    1. Clostridial 7 or 8 way.
    2. Histophilus somni (Haemophilus) vaccination; two doses administered according to the manufactures recommendations, the second dose administered at least 3 weeks prior to the sale.
    3. Mannheimia haemolytica (Pasteurella) vaccine.
    4. IBR, PI<sub>3</sub>, BVD, BRSV vaccination, either one dose of a modified live vaccine or two doses of an inactivated vaccine administered according to the manufactures recommendations, the second dose administered at least 3 weeks prior to the sale.
    5. Cattle must be treated for internal and external parasites at least 3 weeks prior to sale.
    6. All cattle must have an approved CCIA tag, this tag **MUST** be recorded on Pre-conditioning form in order to show and sell.
- You are not required to have vaccines administered or tags applied by a veterinarian.*
8. **Bred heifers must be pregnancy tested prior to Agribition, with the proper CWA Standardized Veterinary Certificates to accompany the cattle.** A separate certificate must be filled out for each pen/entry. The exposure period dates and breed of bull **must** be listed. Parentage **must** be supplied on each pen of bred heifers.
  9. **De-horning:** All cattle, both feeder and replacement, **must** be cleanly de-horned. (Bred heifers included.)
  10. **No Clipping:** Cattle may be washed and brushed. Animals found to be clipped will not be allowed to show or sell and will be removed from the barn.
  11. **Animals cannot be haltered in show or sale ring.**
  12. **Limit of entries:** Animals may only be shown once (ie. animals shown in a pen of five may not be shown in a pen of ten or twenty). **Breeding units may enter unlimited number of pens: this includes Feeder Calves and Open Replacement Heifers** NOTE: Once an entry has been made in a specific class and section, the classification of this entry cannot be changed after the November 1st closing date. Off truck weight after shrink may result in reclassification of backgrounder or feeder steers. For bred heifers, a maximum of two entries per breeding unit will be eligible, regardless of class. If entry numbers exceed the practical amount, then the post marks of the entries will be taken into consideration when determining eligibility.
  13. Cattle must be subject to domestic feeding and watering. Watering tubs will be supplied.
  14. **Show Numbers:** Each pen will be allotted a show number. Each exhibitor must wear a show harness containing this number (front and back) while showing his animals.
  15. All animals entered, **must** show and sell through the sale ring. Because cattle may be on feed and water until sale time, feeder & open replacement heifers and steers will be sold at the following off truck weight: 0-50 miles - 3% shrink; 51-100 miles - 2% shrink; 101-150 miles - 1% shrink and over 150 miles - 0% shrink. **Commercial Cattle arriving prior to printed arrival times will be sold at a 3% shrink.** Bred and open replacement heifers will be sold by the dollar, rather than by the pound. (Pens of 10 bred heifers may be sold in lots of five (5) at the discretion of the Committee.)
  16. **Sales Management:** Canadian Western Agribition provides as a venue only, and has no responsibility to either the seller or buyer.
  17. **Sale Commission:** 3% plus GST.

**NOTE: Electronic marketing devices (video machines, etc.) are not permitted in the stalling area of the commercial cattle barn.**

**NOTE:** If entries warrant, classes will be split at the discretion of the Committee.

## COMMERCIAL CATTLE SPECIALS

**THE SASKATCHEWAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION** *Saskatchewan Angus Champion Jackets will be awarded to the overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion winners of Feeder Heifers, Open Heifers, Bred Heifers, Feeder Steers & Backgrounder Steers. In addition, the Saskatchewan Angus Association offers a \$200.00 certificate to the Champion Pens in all sections, and a \$100.00 certificate to the Reserve Champion Pens. These awards are offered provided the winners are 50% or more Angus breeding, declared at time of entry, and show Angus characteristics. Certificates may be used toward purchase at any Angus sale in Saskatchewan within twenty four months.*

**THE CANADIAN RED ANGUS PROMOTION SOCIETY** *gives \$200 to the highest placing Red Angus influence in the following: Feeder Heifers, Open Heifers, Bred Heifers, Feeder Steers & Backgrounder Steers. These awards are made subject to animals showing Red Angus influence declared at time of entry.*

**THE CANADIAN BELGIAN BLUE ASSOCIATION** *offers \$500.00 to the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder & Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Bred Heifers & Open Replacement Heifers, and \$250.00 to the Reserve Grand Champions in these categories. These awards are made subject to the winners being sired by a Purebred or Fullblood Belgian Blue, declared at time of entry.*

**THE SASKATCHEWAN-CANADIAN CHAROLAIS ASSOCIATIONS** *offer \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Champion Pens in the following divisions: Pen of Five Feeder Steers, Pen of Ten Feeder Steers, Pen of Twenty Feeder Steers, Pen of Five Feeder Heifers and Pen of Ten Feeder Heifers. As well, \$500.00 paid to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pen and \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Grand Champion Pen in the following divisions: Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Bred Heifers and Open Replacement Heifers. These awards are made provided the entries are sired by a registered or recorded Charolais bull, declared at the time of entry, and visually carry strong Charolais characteristics, and winners are a result of five or more pens per Section shown in an inter-breed competition. Prizes may be withheld if tampering is suspected or proven. These awards are subject to the animals being sired by a registered Charolais bull, declared at time of entry (proof of registration maybe requested upon arrival).*

**THE CANADIAN GALLOWAY ASSOCIATION** *offers \$100.00 to the owner of the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder Steers, Feeder Heifers and Steers, and Replacement Heifers, and \$50.00 to the Reserve Grand Champions in these categories, provided the winners have a Galloway parent, declared at time of entry.*

**THE CANADIAN GELBIEH ASSOCIATION** *offers \$250.00 to the Divisional Champion Pens of Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Bred Heifers, and Open Replacement Heifers and \$150.00 to the Reserve Divisional Champions in these categories. The Canadian Gelbvieh Association will also award \$500.00 to the overall Grand Champion Pens and \$250.00 to the overall Reserve Champion Pens. These awards are subject to the animals being sired by a registered Gelbvieh bull, declared at time of entry.*

**THE SASKATCHEWAN HEREFORD ASSOCIATION** *will award \$400.00 to Divisional Champion pens and \$300.00 to Divisional Reserve Champion pens in steer and heifer classes. In addition, the Association will award \$200.00 to the over-all Grand Champion pens and \$100.00 to the over-all Reserve Grand Champion pens.*

**Note: A maximum pay out of \$3,000.00 will apply on a pro-rated basis.**

Conditions: A. Entries must be declared as 50% or more Hereford at time of entry.

B. Winners must have a white face and carry strong Hereford characteristics.

C. Saskatchewan Hereford Association has final say regarding prize money eligibility. In addition, the Association will award \$750.00 to the over-all Grand Champion pen and \$250.00 to the over-all Reserve Grand Champion pen in the open replacement heifers and bred replacement heifer classes, provided the animals are straight bred Hereford, declared at time of entry.

**THE SASKATCHEWAN LIMOUSIN ASSOCIATION** *offers \$1,000.00 to the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder & Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers and Replacement Heifers; and \$500.00 to the Reserve Grand Champions in these categories, provided the entries are sired by a registered or recorded Limousin bull, declared at the time of entry, and there are five or more pens participating in an inter-breed competition.*

**THE CANADIAN MAINE-ANJOU ASSOCIATION** *offers \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder & Feeder Steers and Feeder Heifers, and \$125.00 to the Reserve Grand Champions. These awards are made subject to the animals showing Maine-Anjou influence, declared at time of entry.*

**THE CANADIAN PIEDMONTSE ASSOCIATION** *offers \$500.00 to exhibitors of Champion Pens of Five, Ten and Twenty Feeder Steers and Heifers and Replacement Heifers, and \$250.00 to the Reserve Champions in these categories. These awards are made subject to winners being sired by purebred Piedmontese bulls, declared at time of entry.*

**THE REGINA BULL SALE COMMITTEE** *will award a credit of \$250.00 each to the exhibitor of Champion Pens of Five, Ten, and Twenty of the following: Backgrounder Steers; Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Open Replacement Heifers and Bred Heifers, to be used toward the purchase of a bull at the 2012 Regina Bull Sale. (Certificate is not transferrable and only one certificate per bull will be accepted.)*

**THE SALERS ASSOCIATION OF CANADA** *offers \$200.00 to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Steers and Replacement Heifers, and \$100.00 to the Reserve Grand Champions in these categories. These awards are made subject to the winners being sired by a purebred or fullblood Salers bull, declared at time of entry, and there is a minimum of five entries overall in each class. A maximum of two entries per breeder per class to qualify.*

**THE CANADIAN SHORTHORN ASSOCIATION** *offers \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Champion Pens & \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Champion Pens in the following categories: Pen of Five, Ten & Twenty Backgrounder & Feeder Steers; Pen of Five & Ten Feeder Heifers; Pen of Five & Ten Open Replacement Heifers; Pen of Five & Ten Bred Replacement Heifers. These awards are made provided the winners are one-half Shorthorn breeding, declared at the time of entry, and show strong Shorthorn characteristics.*

**THE SASKATCHEWAN SHORTHORN ASSOCIATION** *offers a \$250.00 certificate for credit to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pens of Backgrounder & Feeder Steers, Feeder Heifers, Open Replacement Heifers, and a \$100.00 certificate to the Reserve Grand Champions in these categories. These awards are made provided the winners are one-half or better Shorthorn breeding, declared at time of entry, and show strong Shorthorn characteristics. Credit may be used toward purchase of a Shorthorn female at any Shorthorn sanctioned sale in Saskatchewan within one year.*

**THE SASKATCHEWAN SIMMENTAL ASSOCIATION** *offers a Simmental Jacket to the exhibitor of the Champion and Reserve Champion Pens as follows: A) Pen of five, ten and twenty Backgrounder & Feeder Steers; B) Pen of five, ten Feeder Heifers; C) Pen of five and ten Open Replacement Heifers; D) Pen of five and ten and twenty Bred Replacement Heifers; and \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pen and \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Grand Champion Pen in all sections. These awards are made subject to the winners being 50% or more Simmental and so declared at the time of entry. Prizes may be withheld if tampering is suspected or proven.
