### **SHOW RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition and the Show Rules for the Boer Goat Shows. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry fee:** \$20.00/entry. **Entries close October 15, GST payable on all fess.**
2. All commercial entries must be tattooed or have an I.D. tag.
3. **All entries in Section 312S - Specials MUST consign to Agribition Goat Sale**

**All Exhibitors are strongly encouraged to consider selling some of their show entries in the Agribition Goat Sale.**

### **SECTION 312M - Commercial Meat Doe Classes:**

#### **Classes:**

1. Commercial Junior Doe Kid born June 1 – August 31, 2011
2. Commercial Intermediate Doe Kid born March 1 – May 31, 2011
3. Commercial Senior Doe Kid born December 1, 2010 – February 28, 2011
4. Commercial Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), born December 1, 2009 – November 30, 2010.
5. Commercial Junior Champion Doe: Chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place does in classes 1 – 4. Reserve Commercial Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining 1<sup>st</sup> place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.
6. Commercial Yearling Doe, having kidded, born December 1, 2009 – November 30, 2010.
7. Commercial Doe, two years old, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2008 – November 30, 2009.
8. Commercial Doe, three years old, must have kidded in current year, born before November 20, 2008.
9. Senior Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from 1<sup>st</sup> place does in classes 6 – 8. Reserve Senior Champion Doe shall be chosen from the remaining 1<sup>st</sup> place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
10. Grand Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from the Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Commercial Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion on its individual age class.

#### **Group Classes (No entry fee, but entry must be made)**

11. Commercial Progeny of Sire – Three animals of any age from the same sire, showing excellence and consistency of type.
12. Commercial Doe and Daughter – Doe of any age and one daughter of any age, showing improvement of the type in the next generation.
13. Commercial Exhibitors Herd – Four animals owned by the same exhibitor but not necessarily with the same herd name.

### **SECTION 312S - SPECIAL COMMERCIAL GOAT CLASSES:**

**All goats entered in the following classes must be consigned to the Goat Sale at Canadian Western Agribition, Tuesday November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 3:30 pm.**

**The following classes are open to all Commercial Meat Animals. Individual animals may not show in any other class.**

**PEN OF THREE DOES: Showing best-over-all conformity and most desirable conformation for type. Pens will be set up and judged in barn 4. (Animals cannot be shown in any other class).**

#### **Classes:**

14. Pen of three Doe kids born April 2 - June 15, 2011.
15. Pen of three Doe Kids born February 1 - April 1, 2011.

16. Pen of three Doe Kids born November 30, 2010 - January 31, 2011.
17. Pen of three Yearling Does born November 30, 2009 - November 29, 2010.
18. Pen of three Does born before November 29, 2009. Must have kidded in current year.
19. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Does.

**MARKET KIDS: Open to youth project animals and all other market kids. Market kids will be weighed prior to the show. Age must be on the entry form. Open to wethers and doelings only.**

20. Market Kids - 50 to 70 pounds.
21. Market Kids - 71 to 90 pounds.
22. Market Kids - 91 to 110 pounds.
23. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Kid.

3. ELIGIBLE ANIMALS:  
All animals must be shown to sell  
Animals **MUST** pass sale requirement inspection  
Show Champions  
1st come basis  
Producer entering a buck, **MUST** enter a doe.
4. All Exhibitors **MUST** consign a minimum of two animals to the sale. Exhibitors not in compliance will be required to pay a fee of \$50.00 in place of sales commission.  
Entries Limited to:  
8- Purebred Bucks  
8-Purebred Does  
14- Percentage Does  
Unlimited Commercial Does and Market Kids
5. All animals must be guaranteed reproductively sound.
6. Original registration papers and signed transfers for purebred and percentage animals must be available at the sale.
7. Code of ethics of the CMGA and CGS will be recognized and honoured.
8. Once animals have sold they become sole responsibility of the seller and purchaser.
9. Sale commission: 10% of which 3% goes to Canadian Western Agribition.
10. Sale is open to all Boer, Boer Cross Does, All Other Purebred Stock and Commercial Breeding Stock.
