SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. The calf from a cow/calf pair may show separate from its dam in the classes for calendar year calves, providing that as a unit, they (the cow/calf pair) don't place Senior Champion or Reserve Senior Champion. Heifer calves from a pair that place Senior or Reserve Senior Champion would automatically be disqualified from showing in classes for current year calves. **Calf Class entry fee will not be refunded.**
4. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls twelve months of age or older (to be submitted at the time of check in). **Semen evaluation must be valid within the past 12 months.**
5. **A copy of the registration papers must be submitted to the Barn Boss prior to show and sale for animals eligible.**
6. All females entered in junior, senior and cow/calf pair classes must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of "safe in calf" will apply to donor females that have produced fertile eggs in the previous 12 months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.
7. All entries must be shown with Leather Show Halters.
8. All showmen must wear a black vest over a **white** shirt to be eligible to show.
9. Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor points will be awarded on the top six eligible animals.

CLASS

1. Bull, purebred, born in 2011 (Minimum of three months of age).
2. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Bull.
3. Bull, purebred, born April 1 - December 31, 2010.
4. Bull, purebred, born January 1 - March 31, 2010.
5. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
6. Bull, purebred, born in 2009.
7. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
8. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
9. Female, purebred, born April 1 - December 31, 2010.
10. Female, purebred, born January 1 - March 31, 2010.
11. Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion Female.
12. Female, purebred, born in 2009, with her own 2011, **natural**, purebred, tattooed, calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in the Heifer or Bull Calf classes, Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire, and Progeny of Dam.
13. Female, purebred, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own 2011, **natural**, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in the Heifer or Bull Calf classes, Breeder's Herd, Get-of-Sire, and Progeny of Dam.
14. Senior Champion and Reserve Senior Champion Female. Calves shown at the side of the Senior or Reserve Senior Champion will not be eligible to show in the heifer calf class.

15. Female, purebred, born in 2011 (minimum of three months of age).
16. Calf Champion and Reserve Calf Champion Female.
17. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
18. Progeny of Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age, from the same dam. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. Name of dam must be listed on entry form when making entry. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
19. Breeder's Herd: A group of four purebred animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
20. Get-of-Sire: A group of three purebred animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
21. Female, percentage, born in 2011 (minimum of three months of age).
22. Female, percentage, born in 2010.
23. Female, percentage, born in 2009, with her own **natural** 2011, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
24. Female, percentage, born in 2008 or earlier, with her own **natural** 2011, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
25. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Female.
26. Premier Breeder.
27. Premier Exhibitor.

Sweetheart Gelbvieh Classic

To take place following the bull classes and just prior to the female classes of the Gelbvieh Show;

RULES:

1. Open to any age Gelbvieh female entered at Agribition. There will be one class for bred heifers females and one for open heifers. Futurity entries will be taken up to 3:00 p.m., Monday, November 21.
2. Membership fee: \$300.00. An additional nomination fee of \$100.00/head for any animal entered. Limited to two head/membership. Jackets given to all members. No Proxy allowed. Must be present to vote.
3. Prize money paid to top four placings.
4. Futurity Champion automatically becomes Lot #1 at the Gelbvieh Sale the following day.
5. Consignor of the Champion Female will retain the right to one flush at their expense and the new owner's convenience.

"GELBVIEH SALE"

1. Manitoba & Saskatchewan consignors must be members of the Man-Sask Gelbvieh Association.
2. **Sale Commission** - To be determined and will include 3% for Canadian Western Agribition.
3. **Eligibility:**
Males - Fullblood and purebred only.
Females - all categories (Fullblood & percentages). All animals must be born before May 1, 2011 (except cow/calf pairs).
4. Animals will be selected and catalogued by sale management.
5. **Papers:**
 - (a) All animals to have registration/recording certificates prior to November 1. All transfers must be signed in advance and preferably before November 1.
 - (b) All bred females must be over 90 days safe in calf by sale date. Females should be pregnancy tested and a signed certificate must accompany the cattle, otherwise, cattle will be tested at the barns at the consignor's expense.
 - (c) All cattle must be health tested prior to the sale date, with necessary certification to this effect.
 - (d) All animals are subject to the standard guarantee which is available upon request from sales management.
 - (e) All females that have calved 150 days prior to the sale date must be rebred and guaranteed safe in calf.
 - (f) All animals must be DNA parentage verified prior to the Sale.**
6. **Entry Fee:** must accompany entry forms. Fullbloods, purebreds and percentages - \$100.00/head, full refund if animal sells.
7. All cattle will be selected. Farm selection fee will be \$75.00/breeding unit. **Nomination deadline is June 30.**
8. Consignors cancelling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entry fee, except on certificate of animals' disability from a qualified veterinarian.
9. **Animals do not need to show to sell.** All sale animals must be entered to Agribition for show by **October 1**, but registration papers, sale fees, etc., must be sent directly to sale consultants prior to **August 1**.
