SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry fee:** \$20.00/entry. **Entries close October 15, GST payable on all fees.**
3. Purebred entries must be registered with the a legitimate goat register (ex: CGS, ABGA, etc.).
4. **REGISTRATIONS:** Animals over 6 months must have original registrations at the show. Animals under 6 months must have registrations applied for and have copy at the show. No papers, no show.
5. **TATTOOS:** Purebred and Percentage animals **must have** a legible and completely healed tattoo. Any animal with fresh tattoo ink will be disqualified. If a tattoo is illegible or does not correspond exactly to the tattoo number on the Certificate of Registration, the animal is not eligible to show, and must be removed from the premises.
6. **HEALTH CHECK:** Animals will be inspected by a Veterinarian and/or Committee of three CMGA members in good standing for signs of parasites, disease, infectious or contagious conditions. It is at the discretion of the Committee to disqualify any animal with health faults. Animals not passing inspection must be removed from the premises. Owners must be present during the Vet Check.
7. All animals shown in group classes must be entered in the individual classes of their division with the exception of the animals entered in the Pens of Three.
8. All Exhibitors **MUST** consign a minimum of two animals to the sale. Exhibitors not in compliance will be required to pay a fee of \$50.00 in place of sales commission.
9. **Substitutions: \$10.00 plus GST per substitution.** All substitutions must be made by 4:00 p.m., Sunday, November 20th. A maximum of one substitution per exhibitor per class. Exhibitors wishing to substitute animals must inform the Show Chairman immediately upon arrival.

SECTION 313D – ALL OTHER PUREBRED DOES

This section is open to all other Purebred Meat Does who are registered in any jurisdiction in Canada or the U.S.A. Ex: Nubian, Kiko, Spanish, Myotonic, Angora, etc.

Junior Section:

1. Junior AOP Doe Kid, born June 1 - August 31, 2011.
2. Intermediate AOP Doe Kid, born March 1 - May 31, 2011.
3. Senior AOP Doe Kid, born December 1, 2010 - February 28, 2011.
4. Yearling AOP Doe, dry (not having kidded). December 1, 2009 - November 30, 2010.
5. Junior Champion AOP Doe: Chosen from 1st place does in classes 1-4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining 1st place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section:

6. Yearling AOP Doe, having kidded, born December 1, 2009 - November 30, 2010.
7. AOP Doe, two years old, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2008 -November 30, 2009.

8. AOP Doe, three years old and over, must have kidded in current year, born before November 30, 2008.
9. Senior Champion AOP Doe: chosen from all first place does in classes 6-8. Reserve Senior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
10. Grand Champion AOP Doe: chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Doe shall be chosen from the remaining champion and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion in its individual class.

SECTION 313B – ALL OTHER PUREBRED BUCKS

This section is open to all other Purebred Bucks who are registered in any jurisdiction in Canada or the U.S.A. Ex: Nubian, Kiko, Spanish, Myotonic, Angora, etc.

Junior Section:

11. Junior AOP Buck Kid, born June 1 - August 31, 2011.
12. Intermediate AOP Buck Kid, born March 1 - May 31, 2011.
13. Senior AOP Buck Kid, born December 1, 2009 - February 28, 2011.
14. Yearling AOP Buck, born December 1, 2009 - November 30, 2010.
15. Junior Champion AOP Buck: chosen from all first place bucks in classes 21-24. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners plus the animal which stood second to the Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section:

16. AOP Buck, two years old, born December 1, 2008 - November 30, 2009.
17. AOP Buck, three years old, born December 1, 2007 - November 30, 2008.
18. AOP Buck, four years and over, born before December 1, 2007.
19. Senior Champion AOP Buck: chosen from the first place bucks in classes 26-28. Reserve Senior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners plus the animal which stood second to the Champion in its individual age class.
20. Grand Champion AOP Buck: chosen from the Junior and Senior Champions. Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Buck shall be chosen from the remaining champions and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

SECTION 310S – CHILDREN'S CLASSES

No entry fee, but entry must be made. If the animal is NOT entered in the open Goat shows \$20.00 entry fee plus GST will apply.)

Youth Classes: Youth must register with the show desk before 9:00 a.m. Monday, November 21st. They will need to register name, age, date of birth of animal, weight of animal and hand in their scrapbook. (Animals will be weighed before 9:00 a.m.). The animal must be registered with Agribition by October 15.

2. Costume Classes. Handler and goat must be in costume.
 - a) Ages 12 and over.
 - b) Ages 7 to 11.
 - c) Ages 6 and under.
