SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fees:** Single entries - \$20.00/entry. GST payable on all fees, **(Entry fees now include enviro fees).**
"Show Only" Fee: \$40.00/head fee on Purebred animals that are entered for show only. Exhibitors will be exempt from the "show only" fee if the consignor enters a minimum of two sheep into the S.S.B.A. sheep sale. Junior show entries are exempt. **The show only fee will be administered by the SSBA.**
3. **As of January 1, 2004 all sheep and lambs must bear an approved CSIP ear tag before they leave the farm of origin and any subsequent premises.**
4. **Substitution Fees:** \$10.00/animal plus GST. All substitutions must be made by 2:00 p.m., Thursday, November 24 at the CWA Show & Sale office.
5. **All sheep must be purebred and registered with CSBA. ALL sheep MUST HAVE a legible and completely healed tattoo. Any animal with fresh tattoo ink will be disqualified. (refer to rule #24).**
6. Sheep will be mouthed to be eligible to show as follows:
Lambs - First pair of temporary incisors must still be in place.
Yearlings - Third pair of temporary incisors must still in place.
7. All sheep will be inspected by a culling committee at approx. 1:00 p.m., Thursday, November 24. Exhibitor or representative "must be present" at inspection by the culling committee and original certificate of registration papers must be available to the culling committee at this time. All animals showing signs of lice, **keds**, long tails or unthriftiness will be barred from the show or sale, and must be removed from the barn. **Refer to health regulations in general rules.**
8. **Fleece Requirements:** It is recommended that all animals be show clipped and clean. Absolutely no manure tags.
9. In order to have a Breed Show there must be a minimum of three exhibitors and 10 animals exhibited in each Section. Management reserves the right to combine Sections if there are insufficient entries in a classification.
10. Sheep can arrive after 8:00 a.m., Thursday, November 24; and must be in barns by 12:00 noon, Thursday, November 24. Sale and all other Sheep will be released at 6:00 p.m., Saturday, November 26.

11. Exhibitors are required to wear a white shirt and black pants when showing. Failure to comply with this rule will result in the Exhibitor being banned the following year.
12. All sheep in the barn must have access to water at all times and under no circumstances will muzzles on animals be tolerated.

CLASS

1. Mature Ewe Two Years Old or Older.
2. Ewe with current year lamb at side (Born January 1, 2011 or Later).
3. Yearling Ewe.
4. Fall Born Ewe Lamb (August 1, 2010 to November 27, 2010)
5. Ewe Lamb. (November 28, 2010 to Last Day of February 2011).
6. Ewe Lamb. (March 1, 2011 and Later).
7. Grand Champion Ewe and Reserve Grand Champion Ewe.
8. Mature Ram Two Years Old or Older.
9. Yearling Ram.
10. Fall Born Ram Lamb (August 1, 2010 to November 27, 2010)
11. Ram Lamb.(November 28, 2010 to Last Day of February, 2011).
12. Ram Lamb. (March 1, 2011 and Later).
13. Grand Champion Ram and Reserve Grand Champion Ram.
14. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals by the same sire, born the property of the exhibitor. First pair of temporary incisors must still be in place. Both sexes represented. These must be lambs. Animals may or may not have been exhibited in the previous classes. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
15. Breeder's Flock: A group of four animals bred and owned by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
16. Premier Breeder: Sheep must be exhibited at the show by the breeder to be eligible for Premier Breeder points.
17. Rookie of the year: No entry has to be made, but must be a first time exhibitor. Points are to be awarded the same as the Premier Breeder scoring system. Exhibitor must be current owner and breeder of animals shown.

INTERPROVINCIAL COMPETITION - *Groups of four head from the purebred classes. Both sexes represented. Two groups from each province to qualify. (Groups to be selected by the breeders participating.) Each group shall be of one breed.*

SUPREME CHAMPION EWE, RAM & BREEDERS FLOCK - Banners presented by Canadian Sheep Breeder's Association. Open to Breeds recognized by the Canadian Sheep Breeder's Association.

JUNIOR SHOW - SECTION 300J

SHOW: 10:00 a.m., Saturday, November 26

SHOW RULES

1. **No CWA entry fee** but entry must be made by October 15 with regular sheep show entries.
2. Junior fees are exempt from the SSBA "Show Only" fee.
3. Open to boys and girls 18 years and younger.
4. Ewes of any breed or breed cross eligible to compete.
5. Health requirements for sheep apply as listed in Show regulations.

CLASS

1. Ewe lamb - Ribbons only.
2. Yearling Ewe - Ribbons only.
3. Mature Ewe Two Years Old or Older
4. **Showmanship: No entry fee**, but entry must be made at the Saskatchewan Sheep Breeders' booth prior to 3:00 p.m., Friday, November 25. Entrants need not own the animal. *Awards provided by Sask. Sheep Breeds Association.*
Costume Class
5. Junior Costume Class: 10:00 a.m., Saturday, November 26. Entrants need not own the animal they are showing (18 years and under).
6. Adult Costume Class to follow the Junior Costume Class on Saturday, November 26. No entry fee required (18 years and over).

MARKET LAMBS - SECTION 300M

SHOW: 5:00 p.m., Thursday, November 24

JUDGE: TBA

SALE: Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Lamb, will sell at the SSBA Sheep Sale.

Weighing and tagging of Market lambs will take place immediately prior to the show Thursday, November 24. All lambs must be dry at weighing. No wet lambs accepted.

SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** Single entries - \$20.00/entry; **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **As of January 1, 2004 all sheep and lambs must bear an approved CSIP ear tag before they leave the farm of origin and any subsequent premises.**
4. All lambs must be shown. No breeding unit may show more than two entries in each class.
5. All animals must be castrated, docked and completely healed. Hair Sheep exempted from docking rule.
6. All lambs must be washed and show clipped, absolutely no manure tags. **Disqualification will result prior to show time if rule is not adhered to.**
7. All lambs must remain in their allotted stalls after weighing.
8. Lambs must weigh 90 - 120 lbs. Entries may be divided by the committee into equal classes according to weight.
9. **Consignors will have the option to take their lambs home or to consign them to the sale.** Commission for lambs consigned will be 10% (3% to CWA and 7% to SSBA). Grand and Reserve Champions will become the property of the Class Sponsors.
10. All sheep in the barn must have access to water at all times and under no circumstances will muzzles on animals be tolerated.

SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$20.00/pen . **GST payable on all fees.**
3. **As of January 1, 2004 all sheep and lambs must bear an approved CSIP ear tag before they leave the farm of origin and any subsequent premises.**
4. No exhibitor may show more than two entries in each class.
5. All entries must be shown and sold.
6. Purebred Sheep in this section may also show in the classes of their respective breed shows.
7. It is recommended that all animals be show clipped and clean. **NO** manure tags.
8. Sheep must have access to water at times and under no circumstances will muzzles on animals be tolerated.
9. Commercial pens will show in their pens. Purebred pens will show in the ring, in conjunction with the Purebred Sheep Show.
10. Movement of the commercial and purebred pens of 2, 3, and 5 sheep, in and out of the show and/or sale ring is the sole responsibility of the owner. If the pens do not arrive at the ring prior to sale time, the pen entry will be disqualified from the sale.

5. Ewe with Current Year Lamb at side (Born January 1, 2011 or Later).
6. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Single Commercial Ewe.
7. Pen of Five Commercial Ewe Lambs (November 28, 2010 - Last day of February, 2011).
8. Pen of Five Commercial Ewe Lambs (March 1, 2011 and Later).
9. Pen of Three Commercial Ewe Lambs (November 28, 2010 - Last day of February 2011).
10. Pen of Three Commercial Ewe Lambs (March 1, 2011 and Later).
11. Pen of Two Commercial Ewe Lambs (November 28, 2010 - Last day of February 2011).
12. Pen of Two Commercial Ewe Lambs (March 1, 2011 and Later).
13. Pen of Two Commercial Yearling Ewes.
14. Pen of Two Commercial Mature Ewes Two Years Old or Older.
15. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Commercial Ewes.
16. Pen of Three Purebred Ewe Lambs (all breeds). (November 28, 2010 - Last day of February, 2011)

RULES FOR SSBA SHEEP SALE

1. **All rams entered in the sale must be shown. All rams must be CSBA registered to be eligible to sell in the sale.**
2. Ewes need not be shown to be sold, but if not shown, they must pass inspection by a culling committee. However, ewes in Sections 300P must be shown & sold at the Sheep Sale.
3. **Sale Entry Fees:** A fee of \$20.00/head must be sent to Canadian Western Agribition for all SALE ONLY sheep. **GST payable on all fees.**
4. **Export Certification:** Unless otherwise stated all animals are not export certified. Any costs associated with export certification are the responsibility of the purchaser unless prior arrangements have been made between seller and purchaser.
5. **Sale Commission:** 7% to Saskatchewan Sheep Breeder's Association; 3% to Canadian Western Agribition.
6. **Show & Sale Entries:** will be listed on one form only and must be sent to CWA by October 15.
7. Registration papers and signed transfers for registered sheep must be presented upon arrival at Agribition to the SSBA. If papers are not provided, animal will not sell. **Closing date for entries is October 15.**
8. **All Saskatchewan exhibitors consigning animals to the show and sale should hold a current membership with the Saskatchewan Sheep Breeder's Association or the membership fee will be deducted from your sale proceeds. This does not apply to out of province consignors.**
9. Animals that are pulled or scratched from the SSBA sale without a veterinarian certificate of disability and have already been shown, will automatically be charged a \$40.00/animal penalty fee, payable to SSBA.
