SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully, as they will be enforced.
2. **Entry Fee:** \$65.00/entry. **Tie-Out Fee:** \$20.00/head. **GST payable on all fees.**
3. Females being shown in the yearling heifer classes, that were born prior to May 1st of the previous year, are required to have certification of pregnancy prepared by a licensed veterinarian. **CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF PROCESSING OR ANIMAL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
4. Current year heifer calves from cow/calf units may be shown separate from their dams in their respective classes for calendar year calves. However, if the pair places Senior Champion or Reserve Senior Champion, the calf must be shown with the dam in the Grand Champion Class.
5. Classes will be split if the entries exceed eight. The classes will be split equally.
6. **Solid black Speckle Park of 87.5% will be eligible for show.**
7. **All Animals show in an Association sanctioned show must have a DNA Certificate, commercial show animals are exempted.**

SECTION 185

CLASS

1. Yearling Heifer - Born January 1 to May 31, 2010.
2. Yearling Heifer - Born June 1 to December 31, 2010.
3. Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Female.
4. Two-year-old Heifer - Born January 1 to December 31, 2009 with her own 2011 **natural**, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes.
5. Mature Cow - Born prior to January 1, 2009 with her own 2011 **natural**, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in heifer or bull calf classes.
6. Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Female.
7. Heifer Calf - Calendar year calf born in 2011. If entries exceed eight entries, classes will be split.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
9. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Female.
10. Bull Calf - Calendar year calf born in 2011. If entries exceed eight entries, classes will be split.
11. Champion & Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
12. Yearling Bull - Born January 1, 2010 to May 31, 2010.
13. Yearling Bull - Born June 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010.
14. Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion Bull.
15. Two-year-old Bull - Born January 1 to December 31, 2009.
16. Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion Bull.
17. Grand Champion & Reserve Champion Bull.
18. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in previous classes. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
19. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. **No entry fee, but entry must be made.**
20. Pair of Bulls: Bred and owned by exhibitor. Must have shown in the single classes.
No entry fee, but entry must be made.

21. Premier Breeder: **Points awarded to the registered breeder on the basis of the highest placing of the animals shown in a single classes that were bred by the exhibitor.**
22. Premier Exhibitor: **Points awarded on the basis of the highest placing of the animals shown in single classes owned by the exhibitor at the time of closing entries.**

- Points will be based on points awarded to the first six places in the Single Breeding Classes on the following basis:

1st place - 6 points	2nd place - 5 points	3rd place - 4 points
4th place - 3 points	5th place - 2 points	6th place - 1 point

In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the highest placing in the Breeders Herd Class will be declared the winner.

* Points awarded to animals in joint ownership can only be awarded to one owner.

** Any discrepancies must be brought to the Show Committee's attention, in writing, prior to the end of Canadian Western Agribition.

SALE RULES

1. Deadline for nomination to the sale is September 15, 2011.
2. **Male and Female nominations are subject to approval by the selection committee based on quality and ratio of prospect males, (bull calves), to females in the sale.**
3. All cattle must be shown to be eligible for the sale.
4. **Females being sold are required to have certification of pregnancy prepared by a licensed veterinarian. CERTIFICATION MUST BE PRESENTED AT TIME OF PROCESSING OR ANIMAL WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
5. **In an Association Sanctioned Sale, the Registration Papers, DNA Certificate and a Cheque for the transfer of animal(s) must be in the hands of the sale clerk prior to sale.**
6. All animals must be a minimum of 87.5% in breed status.
7. **Solid black Speckle Park of 87.5% will be eligible for sale.**
8. All pedigrees in the sale catalogue will clearly indicate the presence of any solid black ancestry.
9. Entry Fee: \$120.00/head includes selection and photograph.
10. Sale Commission: 10% (includes 3% to CWA).
