International Stock Dog Championship Trials*

- * **Tuesday, November 22 - Brandt Centre**
First run: 8:30 a.m., 2nd run: 1:00 p.m. There will be a Grand March at 1:00 p.m. prior to the second run
Finals will be at the CCA Finals Rodeo Tuesday night
- * **Entry Deadline - November 1st**
- * **Prize Money: \$3,000.00 added**
- * Limited to 45 dogs

GENERAL RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General rules and regulations of CWA, please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry deadline is November 1. **Entry fee: \$120.00 Cdn. /dog. (GST & Stock Charge included).** Entry must be postmarked November 1. Entries may be accepted after this date for an additional fee of \$25/dog providing the limit of 45 dogs has not been reached.
3. Entry fees will not be refunded except in cases where entries are cancelled on or before the tenth day following the closing of entries. In the event that the contributor's entry is made ineligible for show at Agribition due to the health status of that entry, and a written request, accompanied by a Veterinary Certificate, is submitted to the CWA Stock Dog Committee, then two-thirds of the entry fee may be refunded, subject to the discretion of the CWA Stock Dog Committee.
4. Any dog that enters the trial field during another dog's run, will be handled at the discretion of the CWA Stock Dog Committee members and Judge.
5. **GRIPS:** The Judge will determine whether the grip was necessary. If it was not necessary, handler will be disqualified.
6. At no time may the handler touch the sheep, or he/she will be disqualified. However, if the sheep runs into handler, while blocking them, this is not a disqualification.
7. Timing will start when the sheep are in the arena and arena gate is closed or when the dog is sent. The handler will call for his sheep. The time limit will be announced at the handlers meeting.
8. Timing will be taken as the last sheep comes through the alley and the pen gate closes. The pen gate must not bump the sheep, if it does, handler will be disqualified. Excessive slamming of the pen gate may result in a 10 second penalty at the discretion of the judge.
9. **First Run:** Running order as printed. (All dogs run).
Second Run: Running order will be the slowest dog to the fastest dog from the First Run. Handler will be called twice and then sheep will be turned out.
Fast Time: The fastest time of the 2 runs in the Brandt Centre.
10. **Handlers' meeting:** 8:15 a.m., Tuesday, November 22, Brandt Centre Lower Level.
