

A Full Day of Purebred Beef Shows & Sales at Canadian Western Agribition

Canadian Western Agribition's full purebred beef show and sale schedule continued today with six shows and a pair of sales.

SHOWS:

In the Agribition Maine Anjou Show, Hall's Cattle Co., Craven, SK showed the Grand Champion Bull and the Reserve Grand Champion Female. Bill Wilson, Strathmore, AB exhibited the Grand Champion Maine Anjou Female and co-owned the Reserve Grand Champion Bull with Citation Farms.

In the Agribition Galloway Show, Glenfiddich Galloways, Puslinch, ON exhibited both Grand and Reserve Grand Champion Female. The Grand Champion Galloway Bull was an entry of Diamond B Ranches, Livelong, SK and the Reserve Grand Champion Bull was exhibited by Big Deal Galloways, Delburne, AB.

Agribition's National Red Angus Show Grand Champion Female banner was won by an entry of Six Mile Red Angus, Fir Mountain, SK, co-owned by Box X Ranch and Breed Creek Angus. The Reserve Grand Champion was exhibited by Soo Line Cattle Co., Midale, SK. Wilbar Farms, Dundurn, SK was the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Red Angus Bull co-owned with Ter-Ron Farms and Keith Adams. Ter-Ron Farms, Forestburg, AB also exhibited the Reserve Grand Champion Red Angus Bull, co-owned with Heart Bar Red Angus.

The National Black Angus Show at Agribition saw Miller-Wilson Angus, Bashaw, AB exhibit the Grand Champion Female. Hamilton Farms, Cochrane, AB exhibited the Grand Champion Bull. The Reserve Grand Champion Black Angus Bull was an entry of Justamere Farms, Lloydminster, SK. The Reserve Grand Champion Female in the show was exhibited by Belvin Angus, Innisfail, AB, co-owned by Scotland's Coul Angus.

In 2009, Canadian Western Agribition was pleased to host the 40th Anniversary National Limousin Show. In that show, Greenwood Limousin, Lloydminster, SK exhibited both Grand Champion Bull and Grand Champion Female. Koyle Farms, Iona Station, ON exhibited the Reserve Grand Champion Limousin Female and Ivy Livestock, Duchess, AB showed the Reserve Grand Champion Bull, co-owned with Payne Livestock.

SALES:

In the auction ring, the National Hereford Sale highlight was a consortium purchase of a half interest in a bull consigned by NBG Polled Herefords, North Gower, ON. The group of breeders paid \$16,250 for the half-share.

The Hereford auction also saw sales of a Bull to a Maryland breeder for \$5,000 and a Heifer Calf to Indiana for \$2,000.

In the Agribition Gelbvieh Sale, the high seller was a Heifer Calf consigned by Lonesome Dove Ranch, Ponteix, SK. Fir River Livestock, Hudson Bay, SK paid \$6,750 for the high selling Gelbvieh.
