**\*\*Weighing & processing of Steers: 10:00 a.m., Sunday, November 21 - Canada Center West.** A Livestock Owner's Certificate must accompany animal at processing.

**SHOW AND SALE RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please read them carefully.
2. Entry Deadline: November 1. Enter on-line or print entry forms by visiting [www.agribition.com](http://www.agribition.com).
3. Entry Fee: \$250.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$15.00/head. GST payable on all fees.
4. All steers must be age verified and less than 24 months of age.
5. **All steers have a CCIA RFID Tag upon arrival. Steers will be identified throughout the show & sale by their RFID #. All American steers must have a CCIA RFID tag (Canadian Western Agribition is an approved tagging site). An import permit is required for American steers.**
6. All steers are subject to drug and residue testing.
7. **No horns.**
8. Entries will be divided into class by breed, four (4) steers must be shown per breed to qualify for a breed class. All other steers will show in an interbreed class split at the discretion of the organizing committee.
9. Exhibitors must declare the breed of the steer at time of entry.
10. Substitutions will be allowed at no charge up until processing. Substitutions (including and breed changes) must be declared at that time.
11. The top two (2) steers in each class will return for the Grand Champion Class. The top twelve (12) steers from the Grand Champion class will be sold. **Rope or nylon halter must be provided with these steers.**
12. Grand Champion will sell first. Remaining eleven (11) steers will sell in order of placing.
13. Ten percent (10%) commission (A portion will go to the CWA Scholarship Fund).
14. Top twelve (12) steers are terminal. These steers will be shipped to slaughter. The carcasses will be evaluated and ranked. Remaining steers are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
15. Carcass points will be based on the following evaluation:
  - a. Carcass Quality (Marbling, Fat Measurement, Fat Colour, Fat Distribution, Meat Colour and Texture)
  - b. Carcass Yield
  - c. Dressing Percentage and,
  - d. Other Factors (Hot Carcass Weight, Carcass Conformation/Muscling).
16. All rules and regulations are subject to change.

**CLASS:**

1. Market Steers
2. Grand and Reserve Market Steer.

**PRIZING:**

1. Grand Champion Live Steer – All prizing to the exhibitor of the live steer - \$5,000.00 added
2. Grand Champion Carcass Steer – All prizing to the buyer of the live steer - \$5,000.00
3. Grand Aggregate (combined score live and carcass) divided between the exhibitor of the live steer and the owner of the carcass - \$5,000.00 added
