CANADA'S PREMIER SELECT RANCH HORSE COMPETITION & SALE and 2 and 3 year old PROSPECT SALE

1. The competition and sale is open to (*pending selection*) registered and grade mares or geldings, and registered stallions, mules may be accepted.
 - **RANCH HORSES:** 4 – 15 years old.
 - **PROSPECTS:** 2 and 3 year olds, prospect horses must be started on cattle at time of selection. Prospects may be shown in a snaffle bit, bosal or bridle.

2. Nomination form and a non-refundable fee of **\$175.00/horse (plus GST)** must be submitted the CWA office by **August 15, 2011**. All nominations must be made on the official CWA Nomination form.

3. All horses are subject to field inspection. Consignors will be advised of date, time and place of inspection.

4. If a consignor withdraws a horse after selections have been made without a Veterinary Certificate, the Consignor will be ineligible to nominate that horse at any time in the future. If the horse changes ownership, the new owner may nominate the horse for the competition and sale.

5. If a horse is withdrawn from the Competition and Sale without a Veterinary Certificate after being catalogued and advertised the consignor will be charged a withdrawal fee of **\$500.00**.

6. Any rider under the age of 18 years old as of December 31 of the current year, competing in an equine event at Canadian Western Agribition **MUST** wear a properly fitted ASTM/SEI or BSI approved helmet.

7. All Ranch Horses selected for the sale must compete in the Ranch Horse Competition. **Ranch Horses *MUST* sell to receive competition prize money.**

8. Horses must be tested for Equine Infectious Anaemia (*Coggins Tested*) after October 1st, 2011. **The original negative E.I.A. certificate** must accompany the horse to Agribition.

9. Consignors of selected horses will receive a letter indicating arrival time. Stall fee is \$36.75 (GST included), Stock charge for the demonstration is \$31.50 (GST included). Stall fee and stock charge is payable before November 2, 2011.

10. Veterinary Inspection: Prior to the Ranch Horse Competition, all horses will be subject to veterinary inspection.

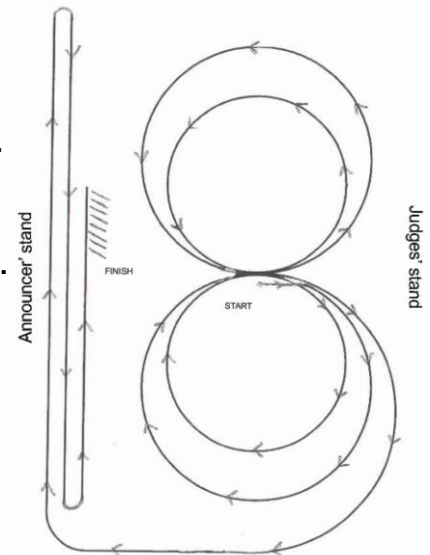
- Veterinary inspection will be done in catalogue order.
- **No riding, lounging or exercising of horses the morning prior to inspection. Breach of this rule may result in disqualification.**
- Horses will be subject to mousing for age.
- **Horses that fail to pass the Veterinary Inspection or are withdrawn, for any reason, from the sale will be removed from Sale Barn immediately following the Veterinary Inspection.**
- The veterinary inspection findings are the property of CWA and will not be released to a third party.

11. Ranch Horse Competition:

- Horses will compete in the reverse of the catalogue order.
- Horses 6 years and over **MUST** be shown in a bridle, horses 5 years and under may be shown in a snaffle bit, bosal or bridle. Credit will be given for showing one-handed with a bridle.
- Shoes in excess of 3/4" wide will not be allowed.

PATTERN TO BE FOLLOWED FOR RANCH HORSE COMPETITION:

1. Each exhibitor will be allowed a maximum of 9 minutes to complete the prescribed pattern. At the 7 minute mark there will be a warning whistle. When the 9 minute time limit has expired, the exhibitor will be required to discontinue work but will be marked up to where time expired.
2. Going off pattern or any additional maneuver in an element of the competition will result in a score of "0" for that element.
3. Each horse will be led into the ring saddled.
Remove the bit completely from the horse's mouth and re-bridle.
Ground tie (no hobbling) and pick up all four of the horse's feet.
4. Mount horse, pick up slicker, set down slicker,
and ride to centre of arena and stop, facing the announcer's stand.
5. Begin; large fast circle to the right, followed by small slow circle to the right. *Circles not Figure 8's
6. Lead change in centre.
7. Large fast circle to the left, followed by small slow circle to the left.
8. Lead change at centre to the right.
9. Run around end of arena and run down and stop.
10. Roll back to the right.
11. Run down, stop and roll back to the left.
12. Run past centre, stop and back up 10' to 15'.
13. Work yearling by boxing on the end of arena.
Turn yearling at least once each way on the fence.
14. Track and rope the yearling and bring the animal to a stop
(do not drag the animal) and track the yearling out of the arena.
15. Drag the log to the centre of the arena from the roping box, circle and return to the starting point back up and drag log back into roping box.
16. Open and close the gate from horse.
17. Load and unload horse into the stock trailer.
18. Following the competition the mouth and sides will be examined for blood – any blood will result in a score of "0".



12. Ranch Horse and Prospect Sale:

- Horses will sell in catalogue order. However, the competition winner can pick their spot in the sale.
- No reserve bids or buy-backs.
- The seller warrants that the horse offered for sale is free of all encumbrances.
- **Horses become the responsibility of the buyer after purchase.** Terms of the sale are cash. **No credit cards accepted.** Personalized cheques are considered cash. Payment is to be made the day of the sale; the bill of sale will serve as a release for the horse to leave the grounds.
- **For Registered horses:** Horses must be consigned in the name of the owner on the registration papers. **Cheques will be made to only the name on the registration papers.** Signed transfer and original registration must accompany the horse to the sale. Registration papers will be held by CWA until cheques clear the bank. At such time, they, along with the signed transfer certificate will be mailed to the purchaser. **Responsibility for Transfer of Ownership shall remain with purchaser and consignor.**
- Canadian Western Agribition provides a venue for the sale, but assumes no liability for either the buyer or the seller. Information provided in sale catalogue is provided by the seller. Canadian Western Agribition cannot guarantee the accuracy of statements made in the catalogue. Announcements made at the time of the auction will take precedence over material printed in the catalogue.
- GST will be charged on the purchase price.
- 7% selling commission to Canadian Western Agribition.
- Following the sale blood samples will be drawn and held for drug testing.

Agribition reserves the right to reject any horse. Violation of any entry or competition rule may result in disciplinary action. CWA reserves the right to remove from its premises and ban any person and/or animal who/which fails to conform to acceptable standards of public health and safety, animal welfare, animal disease prevention and biosecurity, such standards to be determined by CWA.

ELEMENTS OF SELECTION

(This scoring system is for the selection process.)

The following will be used as the criteria when selecting the horses for the sale.

A 9 minute time limit will be allowed to complete the following:

- Mounts horse; picks up and sets down slicker, rides to the centre and stops	10
- Circles (1 large fast, 1 small slow each direction)	40
- Lead changes	20
- Roll back both directions	30
- Lope past centre arena and stop	10
- Back up in a straight line 10' to 15'	10
- Demonstrate extended walk and long trot	20
3. - Box yearling then turn both ways	30
- Fence-work (turn both ways)	100
4. - Track, then rope the yearling and bring the animal to a stop (no dragging), track yearling out of arena.	50
5. - Drag the log to the centre of arena, circle and return to starting point, back up dragging the log.	10
6. - Free Style	30
7. - Conformation	25
8. - Sale-ability	<u>75</u>

ELEMENTS OF SELECTION

The following will be used as the criteria when selecting prospect horses for the sale.

	Points
1. - Remove bridle and re-bridle	10
- Pick up all 4 feet	10
- Mount horse; ride to the centre and stop	10
2. - Walk both directions, at least the length of the arena demonstrating a ground covering walk	10
- Trot 1 circle each way demonstrating a jog trot and an extended trot	10
- Lope both directions demonstrating a collected and an extended lope	10
- Back up in a straight line 10' to 15'	10
- Lead departures	10
3. - Cattle Work	40
4. - Free Style - possible maneuvers of skills ranch horses may perform, <i>i.e.</i> : ground tie, flying lead changes, half-pass, spins, work a rope	25
5. - Conformation	30
6. - Points for Sale-ability	<u>25</u>
