Canadian Western Agribition Scholarship Deadline July 1, 2010

Canadian Western Agribition (CWA) reminds post secondary students that the deadline for the Canadian Western Agribition scholarship program is approaching. Applications must be received at the Canadian Western Agribition office by July 1, 2010.

The \$1,000 scholarships are provided to help cover cost of the second or subsequent year of a post secondary or graduate education program. In order to be eligible for a CWA scholarship, students must be enrolled in a program with a minimum two-year duration at a recognized institution in either Canada or the United States. Applicants must have participated during Canadian Western Agribition as an exhibitor which includes all livestock, 4-H and grain and forage classes or active trade show exhibit participation.

Established in 1994, the CWA scholarship program has awarded over \$139,000 to aspiring students. In 2009 CWA's Scholarship Committee recognized the academic performance of five post secondary students.
