Champions Declared at CCA Finals Rodeo Hosted by Agribition

Saturday night provided one last chance to impress the judges and rodeo fans at the 2011 Canadian Cowboys Association (CCA) Finals Rodeo hosted by Canadian Western Agribition. The competitors did not disappoint.

A new Bareback Champion was crowned at the at the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo. Brad Dyck led the aggregate points coming into the final performance. The Gladstone, MB scored a second place 77.75 point ride in the final go round giving him a total of 160 points and the CCA Championship Belt Buckle.

In Steer Wrestling, Dusty Walker, Vanscoy, SK, consistently earned top money throughout the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo amassing 205 points. Walker posted a text book 4.0 second run on the final night proving himself worthy of the championship belt buckle.

Make it four straight Ladies Barrel Racing titles for Dannielle Dinius. The Stewart Valley, SK cowgirl added to her championship buckle collection with a 14.20 second place run on the final night. Dinius' string of money winning runs earned her 150 aggregate points and the hardware.

Jim Berry captured the championship title in Saddle Bronc. Berry finished the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo with 165 aggregate points. The Maple Creek cowboy lead the championship points race through all five performances.

Junior Barrel Racer Jodi Doenz won money during each of the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo performances. The Carievale, SK cowgirl posted a 14.14 second run giving her first place for the go round and boosting her aggregate points to 180 for the championship title.

It took Riley Warren exactly 34.40 to build up 120 aggregate points and win the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo Tie Down Roping Championship. The Stettler, AB cowboy posted a 8.4 second time on the final night earning him third place money to go along with the championship buckle.

The father and son team of Scott and Tuftin McLeod of Waldeck, SK finished up the week with a total 150 championship points and the championship buckles in Team Roping. The family team posted a final run of 8.2 seconds for fourth place money.

Stetson Lawrence was the only competitor to stay on all five bulls at the 2011 CCA Finals Rodeo. The Williston, ND cowboy scored a second place 82.5 point ride on the final night Lawrence's 190 championship points earned him his first CCA Finals Rodeo Bull Riding Championship.

J.B. Moen, Elfros, SK took home the Junior Bull Riding title. Moen earned 180 championship points on his way to the win.
