Rodeo Champions Declared at CCA Finals Rodeo at Agribition

Rodeo Fans were treated to an exciting final performance of the 2010 CCA Finals Rodeo at Agribition with the competitors in every event working to impress the audience and the judges in Regina. The capacity crowd at the Brandt Centre were on their feet cheering competitors in several events.

Collin Adams repeats as the Bareback Champion at the 2010 CCA Finals Rodeo Collin. The Deloraine, MB cowboy led the aggregate points race and scored a second place 77.5 point ride in the final go round giving him a total of 170 championship points.

In Steer Wrestling, Shane Brown, Lenore MB, consistently placed in the money earning him 125 aggregate points and and the 2010 championship title for his efforts. On the final night, Brown posted a 4.8 second time putting him in third place for the performance.

Dannielle Dinius added to her Championship Buckle collection winning her third straight Ladies Barrel Racing title. The Stewart Valley cowgirl posted a string of money winning runs earning 160 aggregate points.

Mark Elder returns to the top of the Saddle Bronc winning a fourth championship title. The transplanted Australian cowboy by way of Airdrie AB finished the 2010 CCA Finals Rodeo with 150 aggregate points was the top money winner in Saddle Bronc riding on the CCA Rodeo circuit this season. Elder was also champion in 2005.

Hailee Williams needed a first place finish on the final night to capture the Junior Barrel Racing title at the 2010 CCA Finals Rodeo. The Glenavon, SK, cowgirl posted a winning time of 13.80 giving her a total of 180 aggregate points and the championship.

Jarid Berglund posted a 8.4 second time that was good enough for a first place finish in Tie Down Roping in the final performance. The Kennedy, SK cowboy amassed 140 for the rodeo earning him the 2010 championship title.

Team Ropers, Travis Nickolson, and Trent Tunke, both of Medicine Hat, AB, finished up the week with a fourth place on the final night. The team earned a total 150 championship points and the championship buckles in the event.

Ben Kinkead was leading the Bull Riding event heading into the final night of the 2010 CCA Finals Rodeo and the Erickson, MB, cowboy added to his aggregate points with a 86.5 ride and a first place finish for the performance. Kinkhead finished the rodeo with 190 points.

In his rookie year Ty Ellis, Sonningdale, SK took home the Junior Bull Riding title. Ellis posted a 76.5 first place finish on the final night on his way to the win.

Travis Reay, Mayerthorpe AB took home his second straight All Round Cowboy buckle while Levi Elford, Milestone, SK, was the CCA High Point winner.
