SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$85.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$30.00/head. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. **PLEASE** provide copies of registration papers with your entries. Copies of papers must be provided to the show officials by processing time. Online printouts are acceptable.
4. Substitutions will be allowed as in General Rules, **provided the animal is owned by the exhibitor at the closing date of entry.**
5. The use of any PAINT product is not allowed at Canadian Angus Gold Shows. This rule will be strictly enforced and any animal in violation will be excused from the show. There will not be any AEROSOLS allowed in the marshalling area.
6. NOTE: All 2012 to 2021 born animals shown at CAA Gold Shows must be "Angus" RFID tagged. If not tagged with "Angus" RFID tags, these animals will be disqualified from the show.
7. Cattle will be stabled according to discretion of the Angus Barn Boss. Single entries must be shown, otherwise they will be moved to an outside area for the duration of the show.
8. It is recommended for Angus exhibitors to wear a dark, sleeveless, V-neck sweater or vest over a light- coloured shirt in the show ring.
9. Exhibitors will have the option to sell show animals at the discretion of Sale Management.
10. Any Angus shown at Canadian Western Agribition is subject to parentage tests and/or DNA typing. Tests to be supervised by the Canadian Angus Association.
11. All Canadian owned animals **MUST** have a Canadian registration paper in order to show.
12. Animals **MUST** have legible tattoos.
13. Cattle showing with foreign registration papers must be 100% Angus.
14. Splitting of Classes: After arrival at the show, classes will be split as warranted by number of animals.

CLASS

1. Female, purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
2. Junior Division Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
3. Female, purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
4. Intermediate Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
5. Female, purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
6. Senior Division Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
7. Female, purebred, born in 2020.
8. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
9. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
10. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
11. Female, purebred, born in 2019 with her own 2021 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1, 3, 5, 16, 18 or 20.
12. Champion and Reserve Champion Two-Year-Old Female.
13. Female, purebred, born in 2018 or earlier, with her own 2021 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1, 3, 5, 16, 18 or 20.
14. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Female.
15. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
16. Bull, purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
17. Junior Division Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
18. Bull, purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
19. Intermediate Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
20. Bull, purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
21. Senior Division Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
22. Bull, purebred, born in July 1 to December 31, 2020.
23. Bull, purebred, born in January 1 to June 30, 2020.
24. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Bull.
25. Bull, purebred, born in 2019.
26. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Bull.
27. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
28. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limit one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
29. Premier Breeder
30. Premier Exhibitor

PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Premier Breeder and Exhibitor Awards will be calculated as follows: 1st place – 6 points; 2nd place – 5 points; 3rd place – 4 points; 4th place – 3 points; 5th place – 2 points; 6th place – 1 point. Points will be awarded to the top 6 placing animals of each breeder's or exhibitor's string. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd class. Grand Champion and Reserve Champion do not gain extra points.

PREMIER BREEDER:

Points will be allocated to the breeding unit which bred the animal. A breeding unit is defined as the immediate family breeding cattle under the farm name. The members of a breeding unit will be decided by the show and sale committee. Jointly bred cattle are considered as a separate entry. No split points will be awarded.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR:

The exhibitor must own the animal at the time of entry. In the case of jointly owned animals, points will be awarded to one owner only as specified on the entry form. The responsibility of designating exhibitors lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry and included on the exhibitor's entry form.

AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION

Banners will be awarded to herdsmen or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.
