### **SHOW RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$85.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$30.00/head. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. Females born prior to May 1 of the previous year that are being shown in the yearling heifer classes are required to have certification of pregnancy prepared by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days prior to the show date. Certificate must be presented at time of processing or animal will be disqualified.
4. All bulls 18 months of age and over must carry a satisfactory semen test certificate within 60 days prior to the show date. Certificate must be presented at time of processing or animal will be disqualified. Bulls with proof of having been drawn successfully or having registered progeny do not require semen tests.
5. All bulls over 12 months of age are required to have a nose lead or ring when out of their stalls. Violation will be subject to a fine of \$50.00.
6. Weights and Measurements: During the arrival period, all animals must be weighed and have height measurements taken. For bulls, scrotal measurements will also be taken at this time by qualified personnel. Immediately prior to entering the show ring, bulls may be weighed again. All weights and measurements will be made available to the audience for each class.
7. **Exhibitors MUST wear the black Charolais Association show sweater or vest in the show ring. White shirt preferred.**
8. Splitting of Classes: After processing, classes will be subdivided as warranted by number of animals.
9. Bulls competing in the Mature Bull class born 2017 or prior are not eligible for the RBC Beef Supreme.
10. Stabling: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to contact the barn boss and report accurate number of cattle being brought to the show.

1. Female, purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
2. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
3. Female, purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
4. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
5. Female, purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
6. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
7. Female, purebred, born in 2020.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
9. Female, purebred, born in 2019 with her own 2021 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1, 3, 5, 13, 15 or 17.
10. Female, purebred, born in 2018 or earlier, with her own 2021 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1, 3, 5, 13, 15 or 17.
11. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Female.
12. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
13. Bull, purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
14. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
15. Bull, purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
16. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
17. Bull, purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
18. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
19. Bull, purebred, born in 2020.
20. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Bull.
21. Bull, purebred, born in 2019.
22. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Bull.
23. Bull, purebred, born prior to 2019.
24. Champion and Reserve Champion Mature Bull.
25. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
26. Produce-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age from the same dam. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
27. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
28. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
29. Premier Breeder.
30. Premier Exhibitor.

## **PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS**

Premier Breeder and Exhibitor Awards will be calculated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place – 6 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 5 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 4 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place – 3 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place – 2 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place – 1 point.

- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain additional points.
- In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd.
- Premier Exhibitor points will be awarded based on prizes won by six animals owned by that exhibitor at the time of closing of entries with the highest placings in classes for single animals. Animals in joint ownership can be shown in joint names, however, only one owner can gain points for Premier Exhibitor. The responsibility of designating exhibitor lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry and included on that exhibitor's summary form.
- Premier Breeder points will be awarded to the breeder based on prizes won by animals bred by that exhibitor with the highest placings in the classes for single animals. Jointly bred animals are considered a separate entity. No split points will be awarded.

## **AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION**

Banners will be awarded to herdsman or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

## **CHAROLAIS SALE**

1. The sale offering will be preselected as well as selected directly from the Canadian Western Agribition Charolais Show.
2. The sale commission will include 3% to CWA.
3. The sale will be managed by T Bar C Cattle Co and sanctioned by the Saskatchewan Charolais Association.
