GELBVIEH SWEETHEART CLASSIC RULES:

1. Open to any age Gelbvieh female (minimum 75%) entered at Canadian Western Agribition. Entries must be made by noon on November 1, 2021. Females under two years of age must be 100% available to the draw winner. Exhibitors of females two years of age and over may choose to offer flush opportunities or ownership.
2. Membership fee is \$300. An additional nomination fee of \$100/head for any animal entered. Tokens will be given to all members. No proxy allowed. Memberships must be paid for prior to voting. Memberships and Nominations can be purchased on the CWA online livestock entry system.
3. The Gelbvieh Sweetheart Champion is chosen by popular vote of the membership and receives 10% of the payout.
4. The draw winner is able to choose from any entered female following the terms of the exhibitor who receives 80% of the payout.
5. Online voting is available through Man/Sask Gelbvieh

SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$85.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$30.00/head. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. The calf from a cow/calf pair may show separate from its dam in the classes for calendar year calves, providing that as a unit, the cow calf pair doesn't place Senior Champion or Reserve Senior Champion. Heifer calves from a pair that place Senior Champion or Reserve Senior Champion would automatically be disqualified from showing in classes for current year calves. Calf class entry fee will not be refunded.
4. Proof of satisfactory semen evaluation for bulls 12 months of age or older to be submitted at time of check in. **Semen evaluation must be valid within the past 12 months.**
5. **A copy of registration papers must be submitted to the Barn Boss prior to show and sale for animals eligible.**
6. All females entered in junior, senior, and cow/calf pair classes must be accompanied by a verification of pregnancy signed by a licensed veterinarian. Exception to the rule of "safe in calf" will apply to donor females that have produced fertile eggs in the previous 12 months as verified in a written statement from a licensed veterinarian.
7. All entries **must** be shown with leather show halters.
8. All exhibitors **must** wear a black vest over a white shirt to be eligible to show.
9. Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor points will be awarded on the top six eligible animals.



10. All entries must be registered with the Canadian Gelbvieh Association or the Gelbvieh Associate in their country of origin. All entries must be a minimum of 50% Gelbvieh.
11. Balancer and Percentage entries show together. If less than 5 entries in Percentage and Balancer section, no Premier Breeder or Exhibitor will be awarded.
12. All purebred cows must have a purebred calf at side.
13. Exhibitors moving their animal to another split will lose all exhibitor points and that animal will not be shown in any other classes entered.
14. If animals have dual registration, country of origin will take precedence.

SECTION 130 PUREBRED CLASSES

1. Bull, purebred, born February 16 to July 15, 2021.
2. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
3. Bull, purebred, born January 1 to February 15, 2021.
4. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
5. Bull, purebred, born April 1 – December 31, 2020.
6. Bull, purebred, born January 1 – March 31, 2020.
7. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Bull.
8. Bull, purebred, born 2019.
9. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Bull.
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
11. Female, purebred, born April 1 – December 31, 2020
12. Female, purebred, born January 1 – March 31, 2020.
13. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
14. Female, purebred, born in 2019, with her own 2021, natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
15. Champion and Reserve Champion Two-Year-Old Female
16. Female, purebred, born in 2018 or earlier, with her own 2021, natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
17. Champion and Reserve Champion Mature Female
18. Female, purebred, born February 16 to July 15, 2021.
19. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
20. Female, purebred, born January 1 to February 15, 2021.
21. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Heifer Calf.
22. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
23. Progeny-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age, from the same dam. Animals must have been exhibited in the previous classes. Name of dam must be listed on entry form when making entry. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
24. Breeder's Herd: A group of four purebred animals bred by the exhibitor. Animals must have been shown in previous classes. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
25. Get-of-Sire: A group of three purebred animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have been shown in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
26. Premier Breeder (Purebred).
27. Premier Exhibitor (Purebred).

SECTION 130B BALANCER or PERCENTAGE CLASSES (Champions will not qualify for Supreme show)

1. Female, Balancer or Percentage, born January 1 to July 15, 2021.
2. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Heifer Calf.
3. Female, Balancer or Percentage, born in 2020.
4. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Yearling Heifer.
5. Female, Balancer or Percentage, born in 2019, with her own natural 2021, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Two-Year-Old Female
7. Female, Balancer or Percentage, born in 2018 or earlier, with her own natural 2021, tattooed calf at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit.
8. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Mature Female
9. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Female.
10. Bull, Balancer or Percentage, born January 1 to July 15, 2021.
11. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Bull Calf.
12. Bull, Balancer or Percentage, born in 2020.
13. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Yearling Bull.
14. Bull, Balancer or Percentage, born in 2019.
15. Champion and Reserve Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Senior Bull
16. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion, Balancer or Percentage, Bull.
17. Progeny-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, or any age, from the same dam. Animals must have been exhibited in the previous Balancer or Percentage classes. Name of dam must be listed on entry form when making entry. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
18. Get-of- Sire: A group of three Balancer or Percentage animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. AT least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have been shown in previous Balancer and Percentage classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
19. Breeder's Herd: A group of four Balancer or Percentage animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have shown in previous Balancer or Percentage classes. Limited to one exhibit per entry. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
20. Premier Breeder (Balancer or Percentage). Must have at least five entries show in the Balancer or Percentage classes.
21. Premier Exhibitor (Balancer or Percentage). Must have at least five entries show in the Balancer or Percentage classes.

AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION

Banners will be awarded to herdsman or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

GELBIEH NATIONAL SALE

SALE: 12:30 PM, Thursday, November 25 – John Deere Sale Arena

SALE RULES

1. Consignors must be members of the Canadian Gelbvieh Association.
2. Sale commission – To be determined and will include 3% for the CWA.
3. Eligible Cattle:
 - a. Males – Fullblood, Purebred and Balancer only.
 - b. Females – all categories (Fullblood, Purebreds, Balancer and Percentages).
 - c. All animals must be born before May 1, 2021 (except cow/calf pairs).
4. Animals will be selected and catalogued by sale management.
5. Papers:
 - a. All animals to have registration certificate prior to November 1st. All transfers must be signed in advance and preferably before November 1st.
 - b. All bred females must be over 90 days safe in calf by sale date. Females must be pregnancy tested and a signed certificate must accompany the cattle, otherwise, cattle will be tested at the barn at the consignor's expense.
 - c. All cattle must be health tested prior to sale date, with necessary certification to this effect.
 - d. All animals are subject to the standard guarantee, which is available upon request from sales management.
 - e. All females that have calved 150 days prior to sale date must be rebred and guaranteed safe in calf.
 - f. All animals must be DNA parentage verified prior to the sale.**
6. Fees: must accompany entry forms. Fullbloods, purebreds and percentages \$150/head. Full refund if animal sells.
7. **Nomination deadline July 1st.**
8. Consignors cancelling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entry fee, except on certificate of animals' disability from a qualified veterinarian.
9. **All animals must show to sell.** All sale animals must be entered at Canadian Western Agribition for show by October 1st. Registration papers, sale fees, etc. must be sent directly to sale consultants by **August 1st.**
