### **SHOW RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$85.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$30.00/head. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. Ownership: All cattle must be entered under the ownership as listed on the registration certificate of the animal as of October 1.
4. All exhibitors must be members of a National Limousin Association or National Junior Limousin Association.
5. Weighing & Measurements: All cattle will be weighed at the show.
6. Classes will be split based on number of entries.
7. Substitutions of entries within a class may be permitted if the animal is owned by the exhibitor at the closing date of entries (refer to General Rules).
8. All show cattle must qualify as Canadian Purebred with Canadian Limousin Association.
9. All exhibitors must wear the official Canadian Limousin Association grey show shirt or grey show vest.

### **SECTION 145A**

#### **CLASS**

1. Female, fullblood or purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
2. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Heifer Calf Champion.
3. Female, fullblood or purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
4. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Heifer Calf Champion.
5. Female, fullblood or purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
6. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Heifer Calf Champion.
7. Female, fullblood or purebred, born September 1 to December 31, 2020.
8. Female, fullblood or purebred, born January 1 to August 31, 2020.
9. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Heifer.
10. Female, fullblood or purebred, born in 2019 with her own 2021, natural, fullblood or purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for single calf classes.
11. Female, fullblood or purebred, born in 2018 or earlier with her own 2021, natural, fullblood or purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Calf may be of either sex. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf is not eligible for single calf classes.
12. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Female.



13. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
14. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born March 1 to July 15, 2021.
15. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
16. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born February 1 to February 28, 2021.
17. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
18. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born January 1 to January 31, 2021.
19. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Bull Calf.
20. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born September 1 to December 31, 2020.
21. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born January 1 to August 31, 2020.
22. Champion and Reserve Champion Yearling Bull.
23. Bull, fullblood or purebred, born in 2019.
24. Champion and Reserve Champion Senior Bull.
25. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
26. Breeder's Herd: A group of four purebred or fullblood animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
27. Get-of-Sire: A group of three fullblood or purebred animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. Calendar year groups accepted. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must be shown in the previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. Now entry fee, but entry must be made.
28. Premier Breeder.
29. Premier Exhibitor.

### **PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS**

Premier Breeder and Exhibitor Awards will be calculated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place – 6 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 5 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 4 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place – 3 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place – 2 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place – 1 point.

- Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain additional points.
- In the event of a tie, it will be broken by placings in the Breeder's Herd.
- Animals in joint ownership can only be shown by one owner.
- Premier Breeder: Total points will be calculated based on prizes won by the six animals bred by an individual or breeding establishment with the highest placings in the single classes. To be eligible for this award, the breeder must exhibit at the show.
- Premier Exhibitor: Total points will be calculated based on prizes won by the six animals owned by the exhibitor with the highest placings in the single classes.

### **AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION**

Banners will be awarded to herdsman or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

## **RULES FOR SALE CATTLE**

1. Cattle will be preselected by September.
2. Entry Fee: there will be a selection fee of \$150/farm.
3. Sale commission to be set by the Sale Committee and to include 3% to CWA.
4. All sale cattle must be entered in the Open Show.
5. Pregnancy: All pregnant females selected for the sale will be pregnancy tested prior to the sale and veterinary certificates will accompany these cattle for the sale.
