### GENERAL RULES

#### 1. ALL JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.

- Any direct communication with a judge may result in disqualification. A rider representative will be chosen the day of the event, any communication with a judge will be made through the rider representative.
  - Time penalties will be imposed by the judges for rule infractions.
  - A team **will be disqualified** for abuse or unnecessary roughness of either personal animals or event animals. **No exceptions.**
2. All participants in the Agribition Invitational Ranch Rodeo are subject to the General Rules of Agribition which can be found [here](#).
  3. Violation of any of the rules of conduct or Agribition General Rules may result in Team disqualification.
  4. Anyone entering the arena must wear long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, boots and a cowboy hat. Contestants must wear chaps or chinks for all events except wild cow milking.
  5. No profanity, obnoxious behavior, or unsportsmanlike conduct.

**Canadian Western Agribition reserves the right to reject any team or competitor. Violation of any rule may result in disciplinary action. CWA reserves the right to remove from its premises and ban any person and/or animal who/which fails to conform to acceptable standards of public health and safety, animal welfare, animal disease prevention, and bio-security. Such standards are to be determined by CWA.**

## SCORING

### POINTS:

1. All teams must participate all events - **No turn-outs**
2. Event winners will be determined based on total points awarded for the two Ranch Rodeo performances. In the event of a tie in an event there will be a tie-breaker round for the event.
3. A total of 55 points may be awarded in each event for each round. If there is a tie the teams will receive the same number of points.

**If a team has a NO TIME or is DISQUALIFIED from an event, no points will be rewarded.**

4. In case of a tie in the team standings the resolution of the tie will be as follows:
  - (1<sup>st</sup>) the team receiving individual points in the most events over the two performances.
  - (2<sup>nd</sup>) Most Points in Branding.
  - (3<sup>rd</sup>) Most Points in Doctoring.
  - (4<sup>th</sup>) Most Points in Trailing.
  - (5<sup>th</sup>) Most Points in Wild Cow Milking.
