### SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$85.00/entry. Tie-Out Fee: \$30.00/head. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. NOTE: All animals coming to Canadian Western Agribition (whether in show, sale, or both), must be entered in the Main Show (Section 180A) and pay the prescribed entry fee.
4. All cattle must be in the barn prior to scheduled weigh time, or they will not be admitted into the barn or allowed to show. The Barn Boss or SSA Director must be notified if cattle cannot arrive prior to weighing.
5. Entry requirements for the purebred classes are a minimum of 15/16 for males and 7/8 for females and for percentage classes are registered minimum 50%, as determined by the CSA rules and regulations. Please note, percentage animals do not qualify for the Agribition Beef Supreme. All animals must have copies of the registration papers available for inspection at Canadian Western Agribition by Monday. Online printouts will also be accepted. Sale animals whose papers are in the hands of Sale Management will be brought to CWA by the manager. Tattoos will be checked, and improperly tattooed animals or animals without proper papers cannot show or sell at CWA and will have to be removed from the barns.
6. Substitutions will be allowed as in General Rules, provided the animal is owned by the exhibitor at closing date of entry (October 1).
7. The use of any **PAINT** product is not allowed in the Simmental Show. This rule will be strictly enforced and any animal in violation will be excused from the show.
8. Exhibitors must wear the designated blue Saskatchewan Simmental show jacket in the ring. These jackets will be available at CWA.
9. Exhibitors must wear a show harness clearly showing their show number, both front and back, while showing. Exhibitors wearing show numbers on their hip will be denied entry into the show ring.

1. Percentage Female, purebred, born January 1 to May 31, 2021. Class may be divided into Junior and Senior divisions.
2. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Heifer Calf.
3. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Heifer Calf.
4. Purebred, Female, born January 1 to May 31, 2021. Class may be divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.
5. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Heifer Calf.
6. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Heifer Calf.
7. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Heifer Calf.
8. Percentage, Female, born in 2020.
9. Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Yearling Heifer.
10. Purebred, Female, born in 2020.
11. Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Yearling Heifer.
12. Percentage Female, born July 1 – December 31, 2019 with or without her own natural, registered purebred or percentage, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 24.
13. Percentage Female, purebred, born January 1 – June 30, 2019 with her own natural, registered purebred or percentage, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 24.
14. Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage 2-year old Female.
15. Percentage Female, born in 2018 or earlier with her own natural, registered purebred or percentage, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 1 or 24.
16. Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Senior Female.
17. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Female.
18. Purebred, Female, born July 1 – December 31, 2019 with or without her own natural, purebred, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 4 or 27.
19. Purebred, Female, born January 1 – June 30, 2019 with her own natural, purebred, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 4 or 27.
20. Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred 2-year old Female.
21. Purebred, Female, born in 2018 or earlier with her own natural, purebred, 2021, tattooed calf of either sex at foot. Cow and calf to be judged as a unit. Calf not eligible for classes 4 or 27.
22. Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Senior Female.
23. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Female.
24. Percentage Bull, purebred, born in 2021. Class may be divided into Junior and Senior divisions.
25. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Bull Calf.
26. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Bull Calf.
27. Purebred Bull, born in 2021. Class may be divided into Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.
28. Junior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Bull Calf.
29. Intermediate Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Bull Calf.
30. Senior Division, Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Bull Calf.
31. Percentage Bull, born in 2020.
32. Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Yearling Bull.
33. Purebred Bull, born in 2020.
34. Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Yearling Bull.
35. Percentage Bull, purebred, born in 2019.
36. Champion and Reserve Champion Percentage Senior Bull.

37. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Bull.
38. Purebred Bull, born in 2019.
39. Champion and Reserve Champion Purebred Senior Bull.
40. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Bull.  
*The following classes are available to Purebred animals only.*
41. Produce-of-Dam: Any two animals of either sex, of any age, from the same dam. At least one animal owned by exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
42. Get-of-Sire: A group of three animals from the same sire. Both sexes represented. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Animals must have been exhibited in previous classes. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
43. Breeder's Herd: A group of four animals bred by the exhibitor. Both sexes represented. Must have been exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal owned by the exhibitor. Cow/calf entry will be considered two separate animals. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor. No entry fee, but entry must be made.
44. Premier Breeder.
45. Premier Exhibitor.

### **AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION**

Banners will be awarded to herdsman or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

### **SIMMENTAL SALE RULES**

1. Eligible Cattle: Purebred cattle are a minimum of 15/16 for males and 7/8 for females, and for Percentage cattle must be registered minimum 50%, as determined by the CSA rules and regulations.
2. Bulls and females will be nominated, and on-farm selected by sale management. Sale management will also have the option of selecting a limited number of bulls and females at Canadian Western Agribition, subject to the approval of the SSA show and sale committee.
3. Saskatchewan consignors must be paid-up members of the Saskatchewan Simmental Association.
4. Sale commission will include 3% to Canadian Western Agribition and 2% to Saskatchewan Simmental Association and will be no more than 15%.
5. All animals are exportable.
6. All females require a veterinary certificate as to pregnancy status.
