SHOW RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$70.00/entry. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. Classes are open to any animal registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) and/or the International Texas Longhorn Association (ITLA). Registration papers and brands will be checked at arrival.
4. All animals must be tagged with CCIA or RFID tag prior to arrival at the show.
5. No clippings of animals at the show. No trim chutes permitted.
6. Yearling bulls will be shown on halter. All bulls being led must have a nose ring. No exceptions.
7. The Leather & Lace Jackpot will be an additional entry that will be paid to the CTLA. Animals must be entered in the breed show.
8. Classes will be split if numbers are greater than 10 entries.

1. Non-Haltered Heifer Calf, born January 1 to June 30, 2021.
2. Non-Haltered Female, born January 1 to April 30, 2020.
3. Non-Haltered Female, born May 1 to December 31, 2020.
4. Non-Haltered Female, born in 2019.
5. Non-Haltered Female, born in 2018.
6. Non-Haltered Female, born in 2017.
7. Non-Haltered Mature Female, born in 2016 or before.
8. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female.
9. Bull, born January 1 to June 30, 2021.
10. Yearling Bulls, born January 1 to December 31, 2020. Must be shown on halter with nose lead.
11. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull.
12. Junior Steers, born in 2017 to 2020.
13. Senior Steers, born 2016 or before.
14. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steer.
15. Premier Breeder
16. Premier Exhibitor



PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Premier Breeder and Exhibitor Awards will be calculated as follows: 1st place – 6 points; 2nd place – 5 points; 3rd place – 4 points; 4th place – 3 points; 5th place – 2 points; 6th place – 1 point. Points will be awarded to the top 6 placing animals of each breeder's or exhibitor's string. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by the number of 1st place finishes (if a tie still remains, move to 2nd place finishes). Grand Champion and Reserve Champion do not gain extra points.

PREMIER BREEDER:

Points will be allocated to the breeding unit which bred the animal. A breeding unit is defined as the immediate family breeding cattle under the farm name. The members of a breeding unit will be decided by the show and sale committee. Jointly bred cattle are considered as a separate entry. No split points will be awarded.

PREMIER EXHIBITOR:

The exhibitor must own the animal at the time of entry. In the case of jointly owned animals, points will be awarded to one owner only as specified on the entry form. The responsibility of designating exhibitors lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry and included on the exhibitor's entry form.

AGRIBITION HERDSMAN AWARD presented by TROUW NUTRITION

Banners will be awarded to herdsmen or farm exhibitors putting on the best display during the period of Canadian Western Agribition. A winner in each breed will be declared by an impartial judge who has been requested when making judgement to consider the neatness of the exhibit, the grooming of the animals, and the courtesy of the attendants.

LEATHER & LACE JACKPOT Featuring 2019 FEMALES

1. Open to all registered two-year-old females entered in the show. There are two classes: January to April, May to December.
2. Entries will be \$50 per animal and must be sent to the CTLA by October 1st. the top two animals from each class moves onto the final and prize money paid to the final four.
