## TEAM GROOMING – SECTION 109T



**COMPETITION:** 3:00 PM, Monday, November 22 – Chevrolet GMC Arena

**JUDGES:** Toby Noble, Lloydminster, SK

**OBJECTIVE:** To encourage and recognize the tremendous effort and participation exhibited by young people in the fitting of livestock at Agribition.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$30.00/team of three. GST payable on all fees.

### **RULES AND GUIDELINES:**

1. Competition is open to all young people, 6 to 21 years of age, as of December 31 of the current year. Maximum of 14 teams per age division. If classes reach the maximum number, clubs will be limited to only two teams. Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Competitions are offered as follows:
  - a. Senior: 16 – 21 years of age.
  - b. Intermediate: 13 – 15 years of age.
  - c. Junior: 6 – 12 years of age.
2. Entries will consist of three individuals that will work as a team in the competition and one animal entered for show at Agribition.
3. Each team must supply their own trimming chute, grooming equipment, supplies, accessories, and show equipment. Powerized equipment will not be allowed, ex: electric clippers, blowers, etc. **No scissors allowed. No colouring products allowed, including hoof paint.**
4. Teams will be responsible for supplying their own animal previously entered for show at Agribition. Animals do not have to be owned by any of the team members. At the completion of the competition, all animals must be washed, blown dry, and returned to the owner's satisfaction. **No bulls or steers will be allowed.**
5. **Participants and animals must be ringside 15 minutes prior to the competition.** Animals must be pre-clipped, have dry, flat hair with no pre-show preparation of any kind with the exception of clipping.
6. Judging will be done by an official working in the ring with the teams during the competition. A maximum of 15 minutes will be allowed.
7. It is recommended that you dress as a team. The team must supply own show harness. One member from each team must wear the allotted show number clearly displayed in a show harness on his/her back and chest. **Show numbers must be picked up before 9:00 AM, Monday, November 22 at the Show & Sale Office.**
8. Judging criteria will be as follows:
  - a. Total team participation
  - b. Grooming techniques
  - c. Percentage of improvement in appearance of animal
  - d. Team knowledge of procedure
  - e. Team dress/appearance
9. The decision of the judges shall be final in all cases. Any individual who interferes with or shows disrespect to any judge during the performance of his/her duties or on the premises shall be subject to penalties provided for in Rule #1 of the General Rules and Regulations.
