ARRIVAL: Move-in Wednesday, November 24 2:00 PM – 8:00 PM. All cattle must be in the barn and weighed by 8:00 PM.

WEIGHING: Will be weighed as they unload. 2:00 PM – 8:00 PM, Wednesday, November 24.

RELEASE TIME: Cattle will be released immediately following the sale.

SHOW AND SALE RULES

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entries, accompanied by fees, must be received by **October 1**.
3. Eligible animals:
 - a. Bred Heifers, born in 2020.
 - b. Replacement Heifers, born in 2021.

Breed of sire and dam **MUST** be listed on the entry form for each pen entry to qualify for breed specials, and also for the benefit of buyers (straight and crossbred eligible in all sections).

4. Entry Fees (GST payable on all fees):
 - a. Open Heifers: \$10.00/head (non-refundable).
 - b. Bred Heifers: \$25.00/head (non-refundable).
5. All pens entered must sell. CWA provides a venue only and has no responsibility to either the seller or the buyer.
6. All cattle must bear a CCIA tag and will be scanned upon arrival.
7. All open heifers **MUST** be preconditioned. It is the responsibility of exhibitor to bring pre-conditioning certificates to the attention of the sale block.

NOTE: Pre-conditioning forms, livestock ownership and manifests must accompany cattle to the show. Please fill out individual forms for each pen/entry. **Please do not mail forms to CWA office.**

Mandatory CWA Certified Pre-conditioning Program. Protect our reputation. Vaccinate cattle following CWA Rules and Guidelines. Eligibility requirements include:

- a. Cattle must be owned for 60 days by the exhibitor who is preconditioning them.
- b. Calves must be weaned and on feed by entry deadline.
- c. Dehorning must be completed 30 days prior to the sale.
- d. Calves must be over 4 months of age at time of vaccination.
- e. All vaccinations must be administered at least 3 weeks prior to the sale.



- f. Vaccinations required:
- i. Clostridial 7- or 8-way.
 - ii. Histophilus somni (Haemophilus) vaccination: two doses administered according to the manufacturer's recommendations; the second dose administered at least 3 weeks prior to the sale.
 - iii. Mannheimia haemolytica (Pasturella) vaccine.
 - iv. IBR PI₃, BVD, BRSV vaccination, either one dose of a modified live vaccine or two doses of an inactivated vaccine administered according to the manufacturer's recommendations, the second dose administered at least 3 weeks prior to the sale.
 - v. Cattle must be treated for internal and external parasites at least 3 weeks prior to sale.
 - vi. All cattle must have an approved CCIA tag and will be scanned upon arrival.

Please note: You are not required to have vaccines administered or tags applied by a veterinarian.

8. Bred heifers must be pregnancy tested prior to Agribition (within 45 days), with the proper CWA Standardized Veterinary Certificates to accompany the cattle. A separate certificate must be filled out for each pen/entry. The exposure period dates and breed of bull **MUST** be listed. Parentage **MUST** be supplied on each pen of bred heifers.
9. **There will be no dry displays including tabletop displays in the Commercial Heifer area of the barn.**
10. Dehorning: All cattle **MUST** be cleanly dehorned (bred heifers included).
11. No clipping: Cattle may be washed and brushed. Animals found to be clipped will not be allowed to show or sell and will be removed from the barn.
12. Blowers: Are not allowed in the stabling area of the Stock Exchange, excluding the Bull Pen Alley and Yards pens.
13. Limit of Entries: Animals may only be shown once (i.e. animals shown in a pen of 3 may not be shown in a pen of 5). All breeding units may enter unlimited number of pens however may be limited at the discretion of the committee following closing of entries.
NOTE: Once an entry has been made in a specific class and section, the classification of this entry cannot be changed after the October 1 closing date.
14. Cattle must be provided adequate bedding, feed and water. Watering tubs will be supplied.
15. Show Numbers: Each pen will be allotted a show number. Each exhibitor must wear a show harness containing this number (front and back) while showing his or her animals.
16. All heifers will be sold by the dollar.
17. **MANIFESTS:** Manifest must be correctly filled out for each pen. CWA will make cheques payable to the name on the manifest. No exceptions.
18. Sales Management: Canadian Western Agribition provides a venue only and has no responsibility to either the seller or the buyer.
19. Sales Commission: 3% plus GST.

NOTE: Electronic marketing devices (video, etc.) are not permitted in the stalling area of the commercial cattle.

NOTE: If entries warrant, classes will be split at the discretion of the committee.

PRIZE MONEY: All animals must pass through the sale ring to be eligible for prize money.

1st - \$150.00; 2nd - \$125.00; 3rd - \$100.00 (per split)

SECTION 500B – BRED HEIFERS

CLASS

1. Pen of Three Bred Heifers, born in 2020.
2. Champion and Reserve Champion Pen of Three Bred Heifers.
3. Pen of Five Bred Heifers, born in 2020.
4. Champion and Reserve Champion Pen of Five Bred Heifers.
5. Pen of Ten Bred Heifers, born in 2020.
6. Champion and Reserve Champion Pen of Ten Bred Heifers.
7. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Bred Heifers.

PRIZE MONEY: All animals must pass through the sale ring to be eligible for prize money.

Class 1 and Class 3: 1st - \$150.00; 2nd - \$125.00; 3rd - \$100.00 (per split)

Class 5: 1st - \$250.00; 2nd - \$200.00; 3rd - \$150.00 (per split)

COMMERCIAL CATTLE SPECIALS

THE SASKATCHEWAN ANGUS ASSOCIATION will provide awards to the Champion and Reserve Champion pens in all sections. These awards on offer are provided to the winners that have 50% or more Angus breeding, declared at time of entry and show Angus characteristics.

THE CANADIAN RED ANGUS SOCIETY gives \$200.00 to the highest placing Red Angus influence in the following: Open Replacement Heifers and Bred Heifers. These awards are made subject to animals showing Red Angus influence declared at time of entry.

THE SASKATCHEWAN-CANADIAN CHAROLAIS ASSOCIATION offers \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pen and \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Grand Champion Pen in the following divisions: Bred Heifers and Open Replacement Heifers. These awards are made provided the entries are sired by a registered or recorded Charolais bull, declared at the time of entry, and visually carry strong Charolais characteristics. Prizes may be withheld if tampering is suspected or proven. These awards are subject to the animals being sired by a registered Charolais bull, declared at the time of entry (proof of registration may be requested upon arrival).

THE CANADIAN GELBIEH ASSOCIATION offers \$250.00 to the Divisional Champion Pens of Bred Heifers and Open Replacement Heifers and \$150.00 to the Reserve Divisional Champion Pens in these categories. The Canadian Gelbvieh Association will also award \$500.00 to the overall Grand Champion Pens and \$250.00 to the overall Reserve Champion Pens. These awards are subject to the animals being sired by a registered Gelbvieh bull, declared at time of entry.

THE SASKATCHEWAN SIMMENTAL ASSOCIATION offers a Simmental jacket to the exhibitor of the Champion and Reserve Champion Pens as follows: A) Pen of three and five Open Replacement Heifers; B) Pen of five and ten Bred Replacement Heifers; and \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pen and \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Grand Champion Pen in all sections. These awards are made subject to the winners being 50% or more Simmental and so declared at time of entry. Prizes may be withheld if tampering is suspected or proven. Parentage must be displayed on stall cards during the time of Agribition.

THE SASKATCHEWAN HEREFORD ASSOCIATION will award \$400.00 to Divisional Champion pens and \$300.00 to Divisional Reserve Champion pens in heifer classes. In addition, the Association will award \$200.00 to the overall Grand Champion Pens and \$100.00 to the overall Reserve Grand Champion pens. **Note:** a maximum payout of \$2,000.00 will apply on a pro-rated basis. Conditions:

- a. Entries must be declared as 50% or more Hereford at time of entry.
- b. Winners must have a white face and carry strong Hereford characteristics.
- c. Saskatchewan Hereford Association has final say regarding prize money eligibility. In addition, the Association will award \$750.00 to the overall Grand Champion pen and \$250.00 to the overall Reserve Grand Champion pen in the open replacement heifers and bred heifer classes, provided the animals are straight bred Hereford, declared at time of entry.

THE CANADIAN SHORTHORN ASSOCIATION offers \$500.00 to the exhibitor of the Champion of Pens and \$250.00 to the exhibitor of the Reserve Champion of pens in the following categories: Pen of Five & Ten Open Replacement Heifers, and Pen of Five & Ten Bred Replacement Heifers. These awards are made provided the winners are one-half Shorthorn breeding, declared at time of entry, and show strong Shorthorn characteristics.

THE SASKATCHEWAN SHORTHORN ASSOCIATION offers a \$250.00 certificate for credit to the exhibitor of the Grand Champion Pen of Open Replacement Heifers, and a \$100.00 certificate to the Reserve Grand Champion. These awards are made provided the winners are one-half or better Shorthorn breeding, declared at time of entry, and show strong Shorthorn characteristics. Credit may be used toward the purchase of a Shorthorn female at any Shorthorn sanctioned sale in Saskatchewan within one year.
