Stock Exchange Rules and Guidelines:

1. Displays will be a 20'x20' pen in the Yards sold for the sole purpose of promoting livestock genetics. Pens **MUST** display live cattle.
2. Exhibitors **MUST** have someone at their stall during show hours.
3. Exhibitors are responsible for all display materials.
4. Trim chutes are not allowed in the Stock Exchange premise. Minimal use of blowers will be allowed at the discretion of the Barn Boss during CWA show hours (9:00 AM – 6:00 PM).
5. Cattle exhibiting in the Yards are not eligible to enter any purebred breed association shows, however, may be selected for sale should sale management approve.
6. Cattle displayed in the Yards may enter President's Classic, First Lady Classic, Junior Beef Extreme, 4-H Youth Showmanship, Agribition Beef Supreme Challenge (if qualified), or Bull Pen Alley, however, must follow the rules for each event. Entries in these events must be made manually.
7. Wood chips will be supplied by Agribition and shavings will be available for purchase on site.
8. Agribition will assign the display pens prior to arrival.
9. Agribition will supply mandatory signage for each exhibitor and will hang this sign on the front of your display pen prior to arrival.
 - a. Signs will contain the Yards logo and requested information from exhibitors.
 - b. Signs are property of the exhibitor, however, must remain in place for duration of the show.

- Cattle in displays must comply with the General Health Regulations of Agribition.
- All supplementary power and heat sources must be pre-approved by the Agribition office. This may include, but is not limited to: heaters, blowers, electronics, butt fans, etc.

Move-in: Displays may be set up Friday, November 19 beginning at 3:00 PM – Monday, November 22 by 8:00 AM. Cattle entered in events listed above must be in as per rules set by that event.

Set-up: Display must be set up by 8:00 AM, Monday, November 22.

Release Time: 4:00 PM, Saturday, November 27.

Agribition reserves the right to reject any entry or display. Agribition reserves the right to remove any person or animal from its premises that fails to conform to acceptable standards of public health, public safety, animal welfare, and biosecurity (animal disease prevention); such standards to be determined by Agribition.
