SHOW RULES

GENERAL

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. This show is sanctioned by the Canadian Meat Goat Association; therefore, CMGA rules will govern.
3. Purebred and Percentage entries must be registered with the CMGA and CLRC.
4. CMGA sanctions the following classes: Purebred Does, Percentage Does, Commercial Does, Purebred Bucks, and Market Kids.
5. All registered animals, regardless of age, must have original registration papers at the show. No papers, no show.
6. Commercial animals must have a recorded ear tag.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for their own feed and bedding.
8. Barns open for arrival of goats at 12:00 PM, Friday, November 18, and all animals must be in the barns no later than 5:00 PM, Sunday, November 20. Release begins at 7:00 PM, Tuesday, November 22, and must be out by 8:00 AM, Wednesday, November 23. Should an exhibitor encounter problems in transit, contact the CWA office at 306-565-0565 to notify.

ENTRIES

1. Entry fee is \$35.00/entry. **Entries close October 1, 2016.** GST payable on all fees.
2. All animals entered/shown in Special Group Classes must be entered in the individual classes of their respected division.
3. Substitutions are allowed, however, a fee of \$20.00/substitution, plus GST, will apply. Only one substitution per exhibitor per class will be allowed.
4. Exhibitors wishing to substitute must inform the Show Chairman immediately upon arrival.
5. All substitutions must be made by 4:00 PM, Saturday, November 20. No late substitutions.

TATTOOS

1. Purebred and Percentage animals must have legible tattoos.
2. Animals with unhealed tattoos may be disqualified and may not be allowed to show (show committee's discretion).
3. Illegible tattoos or tattoos not corresponding exactly to the information on the registration papers will result in disqualification and the animal will not be allowed to show.

HEALTH CHECK

1. All animals will be inspected by a veterinarian and/or committee of three CMGA members in good standing for signs of parasites, disease, and infectious or contagious conditions. It is at the discretion of the committee to disqualify any animal with health faults.
2. Animals not passing inspection must, if deemed necessary by the veterinarian and/or committee, be removed from the premises.
3. Owners/exhibitors must be present during the vet check.

GRIEVANCE PROCESS

1. Any complaints must be made in writing and sent by 10:00 AM the day after the protest to the CMGA, the SGBA, and the Show Committee. A copy with a \$100.00 deposit may be sent to CWA, where they will investigate.
2. Interrupting a show to complain is not acceptable.
3. Corrections can be made, if needed, after the show.

CLASSES

Junior Section

1. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1, 2016 – August 31, 2016.
2. Intermediate Doe Kid, born March 1, 2016 – May 31, 2016.
3. Senior Doe Kid, born December 1, 2015 – February 28, 2016.
4. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.
5. Junior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section

6. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.
7. Doe, two years old, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2013 – November 30, 2014.
8. Doe, three years old and over, must have kidded in current year, born before November 30, 2013.
9. Senior Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 6 – 8. Reserve Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place does, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
10. Grand Champion Purebred Doe: Chosen from Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Purebred Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood next to the Grand Champion in its individual age class.

SECTION 310B – PERCENTAGE DOE

CLASSES

Junior Section

11. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1, 2016 – August 31, 2016.
12. Intermediate Doe Kid, born March 1, 2016 – May 31, 2016.
13. Senior Doe Kid, born December 1, 2015 – February 28, 2016.
14. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.
15. Junior Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from all first place does in Classes 11 – 14. Reserve Junior Champion Percentage Doe shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section

16. Yearling Doe, having kidded, born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.
17. Doe, two years old, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2013 – November 30, 2014.
18. Doe, three years old and over, must have kidded in current year, born before November 30, 2013.

19. Senior Champion: Chosen from the first place does in Classes 16 – 18. Reserve Senior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
20. Grand Champion Percentage Doe: Chosen from the Junior and Senior Champions. Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion in its individual age class. Banner awarded by SGBA.

SECTION 310C – PEN OF THREE REGISTERED DOES

Purebred and/or registered percentage pens of three does. Individual animals may not be shown in any other class.

CLASSES

21. Pen of Three Junior Doe Kids, born April 2, 2016 – June 15, 2016.
22. Pen of Three Intermediate Doe Kids, born February 1, 2016 – April 1, 2016.
23. Pen of Three Senior Doe Kids, born November 30, 2015 – January 31, 2016.
24. Pen of Three Yearling Does, born November 30, 2014 – November 29, 2015.
25. Pen of Three Does, born before November 29, 2014. Must have kidded in current year.
26. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Registered Does: Grand Champion Pen of Three Registered Does: Chosen from first place does from Classes 21 – 25. Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Registered Does shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners from Classes 21 – 25. Banner awarded by SGBA.

SECTION 312G – REGISTERED GROUP CLASSES

No entry fee, but entry must be made. Open to Purebred and Percentage animals.

The following classes are meant to give exhibitors a chance to learn more about their breeding program. The animals are judged by improvement in the next generation, consistency in quality of conformation, and type.

Points for Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder are not awarded. All animals must have already been shown in individual classes and those entered in a Special Class do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor.

27. Get-of-Sire: Two animals from the same buck.
28. Produce-of-Dam: Two animals produced by the same dam.
29. Dam and Daughter: Dam and one daughter showing improvement in the next generation.
30. Sire and Son: Son showing improvement in the next generation.
31. Breeder's Herd: Four animals produced by the same herd.
32. Exhibitor's Herd: Four animals owned by the same herd, but not necessarily raised by the exhibitor.

CLASSES

Junior Section

1. Junior Doe Kid, born June 1, 2016 – August 31, 2016.
2. Intermediate Doe Kid, born March 1, 2016 – May 31, 2016.
3. Senior Doe Kid, born December 1, 2015 – February 28, 2016.
4. Yearling Doe, dry (not having kidded), born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.

5. Junior Champion Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 1 – 4. Reserve Junior Champion shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Junior Champion in its individual age class.

Senior Section

6. Yearling Doe, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2014 – November 30, 2015.
7. Doe, two years old, must have kidded in current year, born December 1, 2013 – November 30, 2014.
8. Doe, three years old, must have kidded in current year, born before November 20, 2013.
9. Senior Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from first place does in Classes 6 – 8. Reserve Senior Champion Doe shall be chosen from the remaining first place winners, plus the animal which stood second to the Senior Champion in its individual age class.
10. Grand Champion Commercial Doe: Chosen from the Junior and Senior Champions. The Reserve Grand Champion Commercial Doe shall be chosen from the remaining Champion and the animal which stood second to the Grand Champion in its individual age class. Banner awarded by SGBA.

SECTION 312S – SPECIAL COMMERCIAL GOAT CLASSES

The following classes are open to all commercial meat animals. Individual animals may not show in any other class.

PEN OF THREE DOES: Showing best overall conformity and most desirable conformation for type. Animals cannot be shown in any other class.

11. Pen of Three Doe Kids, born April 2, 2016 – June 15, 2016.
12. Pen of Three Doe Kids, born February 1, 2016 – April 1, 2016.
13. Pen of Three Doe Kids, born November 30, 2015 – January 31, 2016.
14. Pen of Three Yearling Does, born November 30, 2014 – November 29, 2015.
15. Pen of Three Does, born before November 29, 2014. Must have kidded in current year.
16. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Does: Grand Champion Pen of Commercial Does chosen from first place does from Classes 11 – 15. Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Commercial Does chosen from the remaining first place winners from classes 11 – 15. Banner awarded by SGBA.

MARKET KID CLASSES

Market kids will be weighed prior to the show. Open to wethers and doelings only. Open to Youth Program animals. Individual animals cannot be shown in any other class (not applicable to Youth Program animals).

CLASSES

17. Market Kid: 50 – 70 lbs.
18. Market Kid: 71 – 90 lbs.
19. Market Kid: 91 lbs and over.
20. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Kid.
21. Pen of Three Market Kids: 50 – 70 lbs.
22. Pen of Three Market Kids: 71 – 90 lbs.
23. Pen of Three Market Kids: 91 lbs and over.
24. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Pen of Three Market Kids. Award by SGBA.

SECTION 312C – COMMERCIAL GROUP CLASSES

No entry fee, but entry must be made.

The following classes are meant to give exhibitors a chance to learn more about their breeding program. The animals are judged by improvement in the next generation, consistency in quality of conformation, and type.

Points for Premier Exhibitor and Premier Breeder are not awarded. All animals must have already been shown in individual classes and those entered in a Special Class do not need to be owned by the same exhibitor.

25. Get-of-Sire: Two animals from the same buck.
26. Produce-of-Dam: Two animals produced by the same dam.
27. Dam and Daughter: Dam and one daughter showing improvement in the next generation.
28. Breeder's Herd: Four animals produced by the same herd.
29. Exhibitor's Herd: Four animals owned by the same herd, but not necessarily raised by the exhibitor.

AWARDS

Rookie of the Year: This is awarded to the first time exhibitor who has the most points based on number of animals shown, placement in classes, showmanship, and sportsmanship.

Herdsmen Award: This award is to be presented to the exhibitor who best demonstrates the following:

- a. Courtesy to other exhibitors and general public.
- b. Attitude and mannerisms during the exhibition.
- c. Participation in the cleanliness of the barn, aisles, tack areas, and other areas used.
- d. Care of animals in and out of the show ring.
- e. Demonstration of qualities that represent a positive image of the goat industry.
- f. Demonstration of good sportsmanship.

Premier Breeder: This award is presented to the breeder with the highest number of points awarded to animals raised by that exhibitor, but not necessarily owned by that exhibitor. Points are as follows: 1st Place – 6 points; 2nd Place – 5 points; 3rd Place – 4 points; 4th Place – 3 points; 5th Place – 2 points; 6th Place – 1 point.

Banner Awarded By: Canadian Western Agribition.

Premier Exhibitor: This award is presented to the breeder with the highest number of points awarded to the animals owned by the exhibitor. Points are awarded the same as in Premier Breeder.
