### **SHOW RULES**

1. All entries are subject to the General Rules & Regulations of Canadian Western Agribition. Please refer to these rules and read them carefully.
2. Entry fee: \$70.00/entry. GST payable on all fees. Deadline October 1.
3. Classes are open to any animal registered with the Texas Longhorn Breeders Association of America (TLBAA) and/or the International Texas Association (ITLA). Registration papers and brands will be checked at arrival.
4. All animals must be tagged with a CCIA or RFID tag prior to arrival at the show.
5. No clipping of animals at the show. No trim chutes permitted.
6. Yearling bulls and two-year-old bulls will be shown on halter. All bulls being led must have a nose ring. No exceptions.
7. All animals in the CTLA Select Sale at Canadian Western Agribition must be entered in the breed show.
8. The Leather & Lace Yearling Heifer Jackpot will be an additional entry that will be paid to the CTLA, but heifers must also be entered in the breed show.
9. Classes will be split if numbers are greater than 10 entries.
10. Prize money will be paid by CTLA in each of the 10 classes: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$100; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$80; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$70. Grand Champions will receive additional cash payout, trophy knuckle, and banner. Reserve Champions will also receive cash payout, award, and banners.

### **CLASS**

1. Heifer Calf – born on or after January 1, 2018
2. Yearling Heifer – born 2017
3. Two-year-old Cow – born 2016
4. Three-year-old Cow – born 2015
5. Mature Female – born 2014 or earlier
6. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Female
7. Bull Calf – born on or after January 1, 2018
8. Yearling Bull – born 2017
9. Two-year old Bull – born 2016
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Bull
11. Junior Steer – born after December 31, 2013
12. Senior Steer – born 2013 and earlier
13. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steer
14. Premier Breeder
15. Premier Exhibitor

## PREMIER BREEDER AND EXHIBITOR AWARDS

Premier Breeder and Exhibitor Awards will be calculated as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place – 6 points; 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 5 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> place – 4 points; 4<sup>th</sup> place – 3 points; 5<sup>th</sup> place – 2 points; 6<sup>th</sup> place – 1 point. Points will be awarded to the top 6 placings animals of each breeder's or exhibitor's string. In the event of a tie, the tie will be broken by the number of 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes (if a tie still remains, moved to 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes). Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion do not gain extra points.

**Premier Breeder:** Points will be allocated to the breeding unit which bred the animal. A breeding unit is defined as the immediate family breeding cattle under that farm name. The members of a breeding unit will be decided by the show and sale committee. Jointly bred cattle are considered as a separate entry. No split points will be awarded.

**Premier Exhibitor:** The exhibitor must own the animal at the time of entry. In the case of jointly owned animals, points will be awarded to one owner only as specified on the entry form. The responsibility of designating exhibitor lies with the owner(s) and must be determined at time of entry and included on the exhibitor's entry form.

## LEATHER & LACE YEARLING HEIFER JACKPOT

**LEATHER & LACE HEIFER JACKPOT SHOW:** 8:30 AM, Tuesday, November 20 – John Deere Sale

- Open to all registered yearling heifers entered in the show. There will be two classes: January – April 30 and May to December.
- Entries will be \$60.00/animal and entries must be sent to the CTLA office by October 1.
- The top two animals from each class moves on to the final and prize money will be paid to the final four.
- The jackpot winner automatically becomes Lot #1 in the sale if she has been previously entered.

## CANADIAN TEXAS LONGHORN ASSOCIATION SELECT SALE

**CANADIAN TEXAS LONGHORN ASSOCIATION SELECT SALE:** 2:00 PM, Tuesday, November 20 – John Deere Sale Arena

1. Consignors must be current members of the Canadian Texas Longhorn Association.
2. Animals will be selected and catalogued by sale committee.
3. Entry fee is \$100.00 plus 7% commission. Entries are paid to the CTLA.
4. All sale animals will have been shown in the show at Agribition and must comply with the Texas Longhorn Agribition Show Rules.
5. Bulls to be semen tested, except for 2018 bull calves.
6. All females will be pregnancy tested, except for 2018 heifer calves.
7. Entry deadline is October 1, no exceptions.
8. Consignors cancelling entries after closing date shall forfeit their entry fee, unless there is a vet certificate supplied to the committee.
9. All yearling and 2-year-old bulls must be haltered and ringed for both show and sale.
