CWA Introduces New President and Board

REGINA, SASKATCHEWAN – Canadian Western Agribition (CWA) introduced a new leadership team at its Annual General Meeting, Friday, April 12 with the election of its new Executive Team and Board of Directors. In addition, CWA also introduced a new President.
