Day 4 at Agribition: All-day, cowboy-inspired entertainment in the Brandt Centre

REGINA, SASKATCHEWAN – Day four of Canadian Western Agribition (CWA) is a chance to enjoy entertainment in the Brandt Centre. The International Stock Dog Championship Trials take place this morning and the finals begin at 1:30 p.m. The champion will be the stock dog that maneuvers a flock of sheep through a pattern and into a pen the quickest following its handler's commands.

Horse trainers Amos Abrahamson and Taylor Douglas take horses who have never seen a saddle before from wild bronc to domestic companion at 12 p.m. during the Trainer's Challenge. New this year is the Barrel Horse Prospect Demo at 4 p.m. in conjunction with Canada's Premier Select Ranch Horse Competition. Some of the top ranch and barrel racing horses will be judged and timed, determining their rank for the sale tomorrow.
